

4-H Online Broadcast Emails

Parents and Volunteers – We are hearing that 4-H Online emails are going to spam or junk email. Here in Fulton County, we do utilize this form of communication because it is the simplest way to send a mass email across all of our 4-H clubs and projects. Please check your spam folder and if you see RegMax emails. You will need to go into settings for your email provider and allow emails from "RegMax - Purdue Extension/Indiana 4-H". The state 4-H office also uses this form of communication for state activities and information.

MINI 4-H

Sign-Up Deadline May 15th

- Mini 4-H is open to all children in kindergarten through 2nd grade. It's a fun way to learn about regular 4-H with NO COST to join.
- Attending 4-H meetings is not required but each club would welcome, and be glad to have minis attend.
- Signing up for Mini 4-H in 4-H online <u>is required</u> and allows us to send information out about camp, and more activities, throughout the year. In June, the Jr. Leaders host a Mini 4-H Day Camp.

PROJECT ADD/DROP DEADLINE

You have till May 15th to add or drop projects. So if your child wanted to sign-up for a project or they have changed their mind on a project, you may go on to 4-H Online and make updates to the projects. A Static Project Name Updates:



During the enrollment process on 4-H Online you are going to notice a few changes in the list of projects. If your child participates in the following projects: Cat Poster, Dog Poster, Foods: Bake, Food: Preserve, Fun with Mixes, Poultry Poster, Rabbit Poster, Sewing: Wearable, and Sewing: Non-Wearable. They are all still projects, just listed differently. Keep reading!

Cat Poster, Dog Poster, Poultry Poster, and Rabbit Poster – If your child is interested in any of these animal poster projects you will now choose Animal Education in 4-H Online. It does not mean your child will do all of them. Your will child will just make a poster for their chosen animal and follow the animal poster guidelines in the summary guide that goes with that species. Then when it comes time in June to complete FairEntry you will identify which species of animal poster you are bringing for the Animal Education project.

Foods: Baked, Foods: Preserve, & Fun with Mixes – If your child wants to participate in the foods project you will simply just choose Foods now. You no longer need to specify which category of Foods in 4-H Online. When it comes time in June to complete FairEntry you will at that time verify what kind of food item(s) you are bringing to the county fair. Fun with Mixes is now Foods: Baked

Sewing: Wearable and Non-Wearable- If your child is interested in the sewing project, you will now just choose sewing in the project list on 4-H Online. Then when it comes to completing FairEntry you will input what you are bringing to the county fair.
