All 4-H members must go onto FairEntry and enter their projects in the class they wish to participate in. Fair Entry Website: https://fairentry.com/Fair/SignIn/20405

<u>Building Projects</u> must be entered by June 12th

<u>Livestock</u> must be entered by July 1st

4-H QUALITY LIVESTOCK CARE PROGRAM & YQCA

To be eligible to show livestock at the county and state fair, youth must complete <u>either</u> the new Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care program which will only be available in person <u>OR</u> YQCA which is only available online. https://yqcaprogram.org/

If you are planning on attending Open Livestock Shows (in-state or out-of-state) you will need the Youth Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) training online. YQCA is \$12 per child.

Whichever you choose to do, it must be completed and the certificate emailed or dropped off to the Extension Office **by July 1st** to be able to show at our county fair.
