Sports will be divided by the member's current grade in school. For judging, a 4-H'ers grade is determined by the grade during the current school year (September - August).

All divisions of Sports will use the Grant County 4-H Sports manual.

The three levels of Sports are:

Beginner – (grades 3-5)

Intermediate – (grades 6-8)

Advanced – (grades 9-12)

EXHIBIT:

Exhibit only one of the following each year:

1. A **report** of ONE or more pages on what you did and learned about a sport or athlete displayed in a folder or notebook. The report should contain pictures and historical information about the sport or athlete.
2. A **poster** displayed horizontally (22" x 28") on what you did and learned about a sport. The poster can include pictures, drawings or any material relevant to the sport.
3. A **video**, no longer than 10 minutes, explaining a sport you did and learned about. The 4-H'er in the sport project should be the narrator in the video.

Choose one **sport or an athlete representative of a sport** to do your exhibit on (examples of sports, but not limited to): Apparatus Activities, Archery, Badminton, Baseball, Basketball, Bowling, Boxing, Camping Skill, Cycling, Diving, Fencing, Fishing, Football, Golf, Gymnastics, Hockey, Ice Skating, Judo, Karate, Skating, Skiing, Skin and Scuba Diving, Soccer, Softball, Swimming, Tennis, Track & Field, Tumbling, Volleyball, Nascar, and Wrestling.
