

RECYCLE, REUSE, REDISTRIBUTE

County project only, there are no State Fair entries for this project.

Recycle, Reuse, Redistribute will be divided by the member's current grade in school. For judging, a 4-H'er's grade is determined by the grade during the current school year (September – August).

The three levels for Recycle, Reuse, Redistribute manuals are:

Beginner – (grades 3-5)

Intermediate – (grades 6-8)

Advanced – (grades 9-12)

NOTE: The judges would appreciate an attached note with a description of what work the 4-H'er did to complete their exhibit including cost & hours. Also describe what the project is and what it will be used for.

The project will be based on originality and creativity. See project manual for specific examples.

BEGINNER (grades 3-5)

Exhibit an article or display made of discarded **plastic** items. Project record sheet and judge's note must be presented at the time of project check-in.

INTERMEDIATE (grades 6-8)

Exhibit an article or display made of **discarded paper** (includes cardboard), plastic, and/or metal (includes aluminum) items. Project record sheet and judge's note must be presented at the time of project check-in.

ADVANCED (grades 9-12)

Exhibit an article or display made of **discarded items**. You may use any discarded items you wish. Project record sheet and judge's note must be presented at the time of project check-in.

RECYCLING – Check-in and judging

Check-in: Tuesday, June 13, 5-7 p.m. OR Wednesday, June 14, 8 a.m.-4 p.m. (bring project and judge's note)

Judging: Open judging

After check-in of **all** projects, put current year's record sheets in Green Record Book and turn in at designated boxes in the Community Building.

You have until May 15 to add or drop this project from your current year's enrollment.

The Best of Show and Runner-Up Best of Show winners will be recognized Sunday of the fair.
