- One section from a bale; in <u>plastic see-through bag.</u>
- Poster on a topic or issue related to alfalfa, alfalfa production or the uses of alfalfa

# CORN- Exhibit one of the following:

- One full-grown plant with roots intact and washed CLEAN; also, <u>bring a five-gallon bucket</u> <u>filled one-half full with soil</u>. Once your exhibit has been judged, you will be asked to stand the plant upright in the bucket for display.
- One gallon of corn
- Poster on a topic or issue related to corn, corn production, or the uses of corn

### SOYBEANS- Exhibit one of the following:

- Six stalks (roots intact, washed CLEAN)
- One gallon of soybeans
- Poster on a topic or issue related to soybeans, soybean production, or the use of soybeans

# WHEAT-Exhibit one of the following:

- -One peck of grain
- -One sheaf (15-20 stalks)

-Poster on a topic or issue related to wheat, wheat production, or the use of wheat
