



## Project Title: Strawberries

### Description:

Youth will learn about plant growth, soil nutrition, and management of insects and diseases related to strawberry production.

### Exhibit Guidelines:

Refer to Suggested 4-H Garden Exhibits, 4-H 970-w, to learn about size, weight, and other suggested specifications.

Judges evaluating exhibits should recognize individual differences in growth conditions, therefore using information in this document as a guide rather than a requirement. They will also take into account the age/number of years in the project.

## Strawberry Options

*All (grades 3-12)*

### Plants

Plant a number of plants of your choosing. (Youth should be conscious of the number they choose considering germination rates to ensure they have enough to exhibit.) Exhibit should consist of a box containing 3 growing plants from your strawberry patch and a picture of your strawberry patch. Exhibit should **include** a card with common name, Latin name, variety, picture of patch, and be securely attached to the plant container.

### Fruit

Exhibit two quarts of unsweetened, frozen strawberries that you harvest from your own plants. Strawberries are to be exhibited whole, with cap and about 1/2" stem. Exhibit should **include** a card with common name, Latin name, and variety.

## Educational Display

Exhibit a poster, display, or notebook about a topic regarding strawberries.
