For 2024 projects, the application deadline is March 1, and grants will be selected by April 1. Final reports are due by December 31. The application process for 2024 is now open through our portal.



# Indiana 4-H Invention Convention Competition



## CDM- HOW IT WORKS

Consumer Decision Making is a contest based on consumer observation, comparing and making fact based purchases. A team of 3-4 youth are given classes to judge based on a scenario. As a team, class options are ranked. Those selections are then defended through oral reasoning to a judges panel.

\*\*Winners at the State Contest are then eligible to compete at the FCS Classic. This National Contest is a part of the National Western 4-H Round Up in Denver which is held the first weekend of January in Denver, CO during the National Western Stock Show!\*\*


