- 2. Scholarships will be to the school of the recipient's choice; however, awards will be honored only if the recipient is enrolled in the selected school at the appropriate time.
- 3. The money will be mailed directly to the recipient.
- Applications from former recipients of this scholarship will be accepted if they are desirous of renewing this award.
- 5. Application forms may be obtained from the Purdue Extension Hamilton County office or website (www.extension.purdue.edu\hamilton). Completed forms must be returned to the Extension Office by **January 25.**

The Geneva M. Fisher Scholarship will be awarded to the applicant(s) who, in the judgment of the Selection Committee, appear most deserving based on the following criteria.

- 1. The applicant shall possess good leadership potential as well as desirable personal and citizenship qualities. 4-H, school and community involvement will be considered.
- 2. The applicant's academic record and career goals will be considered.
- 3. Financial need may be a factor but is not necessary to receive the award. It will be considered in the instance of two candidates of equal qualifications.
- 4. All qualified applicants will have an equal opportunity to compete for the scholarship. There will be no restrictions as to race, color, sex, religion or national origin.
- 5. Applicants may be asked to appear before the Selection Committee for a personal interview.
