

WHAT YOU WILL EXHIBIT

You will exhibit three (3) pictures at the fair. The pictures may be color, black and white, or some of each.

Pictures should be mounted on 22" x 14" foam board. Use the title for your poster: "My Life".

Your prints should be all 4" x 6".


The three (3) pictures should be of the following:

Kindergarten: 1 picture of a flower and 2 pictures of your choice

1st Grade: 1 picture of a person and 2 pictures of your choice

2nd Grade: 1 picture of an animal or insect and 2 pictures of your choice.

Your pictures may be vertical or horizontal and placed somewhere below the title. The poster should be as shown below. Use the following label and attach it to the bottom right side of your poster.



- Take pictures from multiple angles and distances so you have options when you pick pictures to display.
