I will be taking the items to Life Choices, Hope House, local schools and the Support the Girls Chapter in Indianapolis.

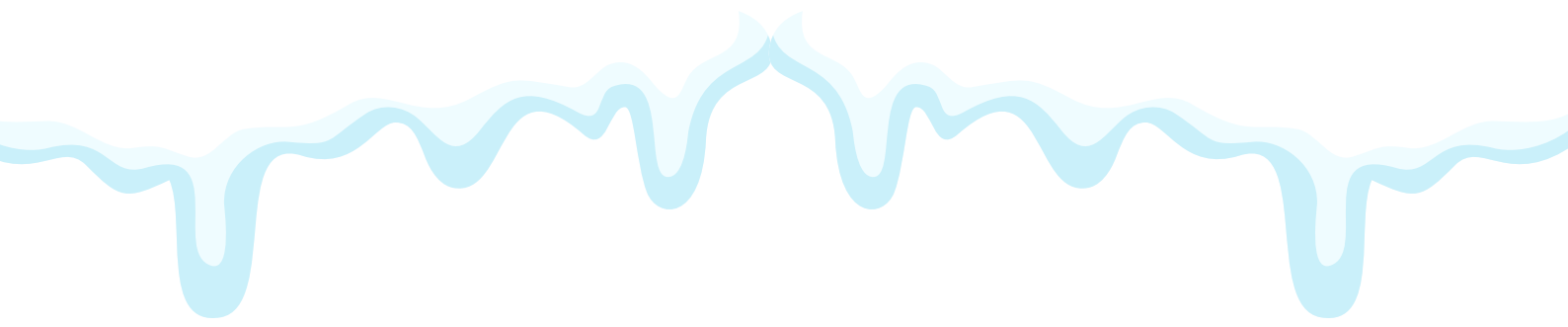
Remember to get your volunteer hours turned into your club resident by January 31, 2026. Also, grant applications are due to Vickie on February 15, 2026.

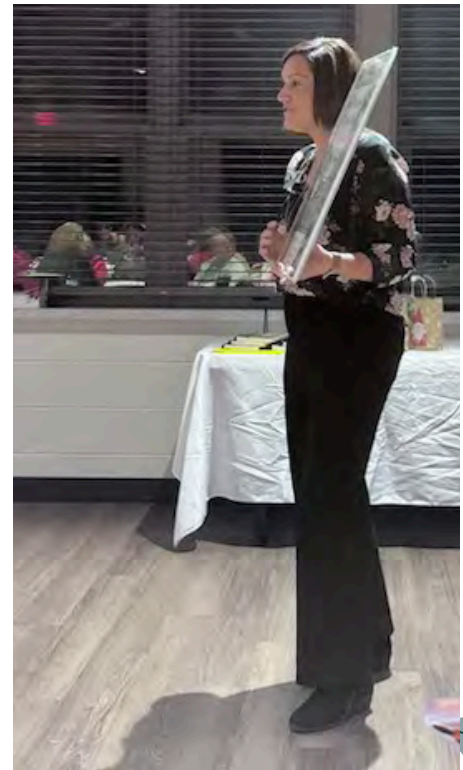
