 Americans eat 17 billon quarts of popped popcorn a year. That is 43 quarts per person.

• Popcorn can pop up to 3 feet in the air.

Popcorn originated in the Americas.

 In southwestern Utah, a 1,000-year-old popped kernel of popcorn was found in a dry cave inhabited by predecessors of the Pueblo Indians.

• 25 states produce popcorn in the US

• Indiana is #2 in popcorn production.

Harrison County is 3rd in the state for popcorn production.

 Hull-less popcorn doesn't actually exist because all popcorn has to have a hull to pop.

 Two shapes of popcorn butterfly and mushroom- butterfly irregular shape and mushroom spherical shaped.

Harrison County is home to 2 popcorn plants,
 Ramsey Popcorn and Preferred Popcorn.
