Dear 4-H Family,

Now that you are enrolled in **4-HOnline** it's time to identify the projects you plan to exhibit at the Hendricks County 4-H Fair in **FairEntry**. **FAIRENTRY** is the online system we use to:

- track exhibits/projects at the Fair.
- record ribbon/award placings and create reports to send this information to the newspaper.
- create exhibit tags that are put on projects/displays/exhibits.
- create show programs for the livestock, and much more

4-HOnline connects to **FairEntry** to help track this information. Think of the process like this:

- 4-HOnline is step #1 where you told us what projects you are completing.
- FairEntry is step #2 where you tell us what you will be bringing to Fair.

EXAMPLE: You might have signed up for the Photography project on 4-HOnline. In FairEntry, you will tell us that you are bringing a Level C Photography project that is a Black and White Salon Print of a dog in a barn.

FairEntry will open at NOON on **TUESDAY, JUNE 7th**. We would like all project information to be entered by **Thursday, July 7th!!** Entering your projects early will benefit you greatly! You will need to enter your project information on **FairEntry** in order to receive your FREE tickets to the Hendricks County 4-H Fair.

Ticket information will be sent July 10th or after, so our deadline is July 7th to make sure we have time to run reports and get the information needed for your tickets. This date also gives us time to print off exhibit tags for projects and help run reports for barn layouts for livestock.

Some basics of the **FairEntry** system are:

- Families will use their 4-H Online profiles and passwords. Families will **NOT** have to create another password or profile to enter information into **FairEntry**.
- EACH exhibit or project for EACH 4-H'er in your **Family profile** who is planning to bring something to the Fair will need to be registered in **FairEntry**.
- If you have a project that you don't plan on exhibiting at the Fair, but want to complete it by doing the book-work, you will still need to enter that information into **FairEntry** for record keeping purposes. See the enclosed documents: STEP-BY-STEP GUIDE TO FAIRENTRY and the 2022 FAIRENTRY CHEAT SHEET for more information on how to register a project completed through book-work or participation via a 4-H activity.
- When entering each project, you must enter your club every time you make an entry.
- You may start entering 4-H members' information, just **DO NOT SUBMIT until** you have completed **all 4-H members in the Family**.
- When you have everything completed in **FairEntry**, please be sure to *submit* your entries.

****Note:** Because this system is a nation-wide program, it will appear as if there is a fee for projects, however when you get to the end of the entry it will show a **zero charge** – there is **NO FEE** for exhibiting at the Hendricks County 4-H Fair!

Indoor Projects:

Project tags for indoor projects will be available for pick up starting **Friday, July 8th**. You will be able to skip a station when checking-in if you have your tags already picked up! More details about this process will be sent in June.

Livestock Projects:

Livestock members - entering your animals early will save you time on check in day as you will not have to wait to unload until you enter them on FairEntry. More details will be sent about livestock check-in in June. *You will also sign up for the auction on **FairEntry** again this year – more details about auction included in this packet!!*

NEW FOR 2022 – Livestock members that are required to take YQCA will also need to upload their YQCA certificate to FairEntry. Because of the new YQCA website, we are unable to pull reports which list who has completed YQCA like we have been able to in the past. It will also be a good idea to bring your certificate with you or have it on your phone during fair.

Extended Extension Office Hours:

In addition to our regular working hours (M-F 08:00-4:00pm), during June and July, we will have a couple of days with Extended Extension Office Hours to help you with **FairEntry** or other 4-H questions you may have! Below is a list of dates/times that our office will be open late to help you:

Monday, June 20th – Open 8 AM to 7 PM

Thursday, July 7th – Open 8 AM to 7 PM

We understand that the process of adding information into FAIRENTRY will take a little time, but this process is required. *Please don't wait until the last moment if you need assistance!!* Again, thank you for your patience as we continue to develop the use of FairEntry in Hendricks County!

2022 FairEntry Cheat Sheet

This sheet is provided as a guide to help you to find your projects in the **FAIRENTRY system**. Some projects are **State Fair Projects which must be completed in a specific way**. Other projects are **Hendricks County Only projects which have to be done another way**.

A few things to keep in mind as you begin working through the **FAIRENTRY system**:

1. You will **ONLY** be able to sign up for projects you are also signed up for on 4-HOnline. You will not be able to add any projects that you are not signed up for.
2. Be sure to answer any questions asked projects (if any).
3. ****Make sure you hit “submit” AFTER you are 100% complete for the entire Family of 4-H’ers on your Profile**

FAIRENTRY Q & A

Below is a list of frequently asked questions about projects and some tips/tricks that will help you:

| Project | Advice |

| Animal Education | Animal Education is listed under County Only Projects. In this project, certain species displays will be eligible to be sent to the Indiana State Fair while others will be judged only at the county level. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • State Fair Eligible Species: Cat, Dog, Llama/Alpaca, Poultry, Rabbit • All other species included in this project will be judged as “county only” |
| Arts & Crafts | Remember, these have been updated this year! They are in STATE PROJECTS with the exception of CERAMICS. Ceramics is in County only since it is judged separately. |
| Bicycle Rodeo | If you are planning on participating in Bicycle Rodeo, be sure to sign up under “ County Only Projects ” – “ Bicycle Rodeo ” – and then select grade level. |
| Creative Writing | This is a NEW project for 2022 for both the County and State level. Members must be signed up in the “Communications Project” in order to exhibit in this project. |
| Fashion Revue **ALL DIVISIONS – Adding your Fashion Revue Commentary | ATTENTION: All sections , you will be asked to describe your outfit first. This means tell us the type of outfit you are planning to model. THEN, you will be asked to provide Fashion Revue Commentary. This is the information which will be read during the modeling. Sewing Project members participating in Fashion Revue will sign up under: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • “State Projects” – “Fashion Revue” (8-12 graders), or • “County Only Projects” – “Fashion Revue” (3-7 graders). Consumer Clothing Project members have new guidelines in which the Consumer Clothing notebooks and modeling (Fashion Revue) are judged together. Therefore, Fashion Revue questions have been added to the State Project – Consumer Clothing. |
| Garden | You will need one project tag per plate of vegetables that you plan on exhibiting! Don't forget to stop by or check our website for the updated display guidelines for the project! |
| Photography | If you are bringing a 10-print poster, please enter the #1 picture description in FairEntry! |
| Livestock | All livestock attending the Fair will need to be put on FairEntry. We understand that sometimes you don't know what animals you are bringing until the last minute, but having animals entered on FairEntry by July 7 th helps with planning for barn layouts, finalizing awards, and ensuring animals are put in the proper classes. If you do not have your animals entered in FairEntry by day of check in, you will have to wait to unload until all animals are entered. |
| Cat, Dog, Poultry | Remember, you will have to add an animal for your projects. Since you do not enter animals on 4-HOnline, you will not be able to “Create from an Existing Record.” You will need to add a new animal to tell us what you are bringing. |
| Auction/Direct Animals | See enclosed document related to the 2022 “Livestock Super Sale” Auction info. |

General Questions about FairEntry:

- ***I entered my project information, but something happened last minute and I had to change my exhibit. What do I do? (Example: I was planning to bring a cherry pie, but made an apple pie instead.)***
Not a problem! We understand things happen. You will need to correct it on your project card and let the person that checks you in know the change. They will be able to correct it in FairEntry. If you know far enough ahead of time, you may contact the Extension Office and we can make the correction for you before the tags are printed.
- ***I have more than one item I will be displaying (Example: a table and chairs). What do I do?***
Fantastic! You will just need to make sure you get multiple copies of your project tag when you pick them up OR when you check in. The earlier you let us know that you will need multiple project tags, the better.
- ***I have a really large project that I'm bringing to exhibit. Do I need to bring that through the check in line with me?***
If it's easier to move your item to judging location and then just bring the project tag through the check-in line, that's fine. We will just need to make sure the information on your tag is accurate for when you get to the judging station.
- ***When do I need to have my information entered into FairEntry?***
We are **strongly encouraging** all 4-H members to get their projects registered in FairEntry by July 7. We will be pulling information from FairEntry to send tickets out after July 10th. So, you won't get your tickets for fair *until* you sign up on FairEntry.
- ***What happens if I am doing book completion or not bringing something to exhibit? Or, what if I am completing by doing a 4-H Activity and not displaying a project?***
We would still like to document your hard work and involvement in 4-H! If you are planning on completing by bookwork or by participating in a 4-H Activity (i.e. SPARK Program, etc.), you will state that under County Only Projects → 4-H Activity → Completion via book, event, or SPARK. By entering this information, you will also be sure to get your tickets for the fair!

2022 Livestock Super Sale

We are excited to announce our new 2022 Livestock Super Sale on Friday July 22 @ 5:30 p.m.

1. Auction eligible 4-Her's will be allowed to place their animal virtually in the Super Sale.
2. The Auction Fund will be divided evenly amongst **all** of the individuals that sign up for the Super Sale, including those participating with live animals.
3. Select individuals will have the opportunity to place their animal in the live auction portion of the Super Sale.
 - a. 10 year & last year 9 year members
 - i. Exhibitor must have shown livestock for at least 6 of their 4-H years.
 - ii. The money raised during the live auction will be split 50/50 between the 4-Her and the Auction Fund.
 - b. Any 4-Her that receives Grand Champion or Reserve Grand Champion will be eligible to take that animal through the live auction.
 - i. The money raised during the live auction will be split 50/50 between 4-Her and Auction Fund.
 - ii. 4-Her must be signed up for the sale before the Fair on Fairy Entry.
 - iii. They can swap the animal for the sale during the week if they are a winner.
4. We will sell numerous other items at the auction, i.e. Swine Club basket, Beef Club basket, building naming rights, premium parking spot, etc. – All money raised will go towards the Auction Fund.
5. Donors/Buyers are also able to give money directly to the Auction Fund to support ALL of the Super Sale 4-Her's.
6. Add-On's are also encouraged to support individual 4-Her's.
7. To encourage giving to the 4-Her's, we are excited to introduce the following acknowledgement levels in the NSSB Arena. We will be revising the Richard Bruner Auction Supporters Board as follows:
 - a. The following requirements and levels will be displayed:
 - i. Clower Supporter - Donate at least \$250 in Add-Ons, Auction Fund donation, or purchase at live auction.
 - ii. Blue Ribbon Supporter – Donate at least \$500 in Add-Ons, Auction Fund donation, or purchase at live auction.
 - iii. Honor Group Supporter – Donate at least \$1,000 in Add-Ons, Auction Fund donation, or purchase at live auction. **Note at least half of the donation needs to go towards the Auction Fund. (The full purchase of a live auction animal or item counts towards the goal)**

- iv. Champion Level Supporter - Donate at least \$2,500 in Add-Ons, Auction Fund donation, or purchase at live auction. **Note at least half of the donation needs to go towards the Auction Fund. (The full purchase of a live auction animal or item counts towards the goal)**
 - v. Grand Champion Level Supporter - Donate at least \$5,000 in Add-Ons, Auction Fund donation, or purchase at live auction. **Note at least half of the donation needs to go towards the Auction Fund. (The full purchase of a live auction animal or item counts towards the goal)**
 - vi. Supreme Champion Level Supporter – Donate at least \$10,000 in Add-Ons, Auction Fund donation, or purchase at live auction. **Note at least half of the donation needs to go towards the Auction Fund. (The full purchase of a live auction animal or item counts towards the goal)**
 - b. The board will be updated yearly around March 1st and be displayed year round to all patrons and visitors to the fair and fairgrounds.
8. Add-On's will be paid directly to the 4-Her from the Buyer.
 9. 50% Auction proceeds for live animals will be paid directly to 4-Her from the buyer. 50% auction proceeds will be paid directly to the Auction Fund.
 10. The live portion of the Super Sale will be our Buyer's Bonanza/
 - a. We will start with dinner at 5:30 p.m.
 - b. Dinner for the buyers will be provided in the NSSB arena with tables for the auction and networking.
 - c. Following dinner a schedule of live animals and other auction items will be sold.

Details

1. 4-Her Eligibility – Any enrolled Hendricks County 4-Her that exhibits animals at the county fair per item #2 eligible species.
2. Eligible species to be a part of Super Sale
 - a. Beef, Dairy Steer, Swine, Sheep, Meat Goats and Rabbit Meat Pens
 - b. Dairy 10 year members
 - c. Poultry 10 year members
 - d. Dairy Goat 10 year members
3. Eligibility for 10 year and last year 9 members to sell animal live
 - a. Must have shown livestock in 4-H at a minimum of 6 years
 - b. Must be present on Auction night to be eligible to have animal live auctioned off – If they cannot be in person, the 4-Her may be in virtual Super Sale with other 4-Her's
4. This is **NOT** a kill sale. Animals may be taken home after required fair release time on Saturday.
5. **NOTE – any animal that is signed up for sale will NOT be eligible to show at the State Fair. Regardless if it goes home or anywhere else (State Fair Rules)**

6. We will have a direct truck to take animals to market. Current market price at fair time will be paid for the animal to the 4-Her's. Direct truck for sale or non-sale animals will be at the fair on Friday night of the Super Sale.
7. 4-Her's will be responsible to sign up for the Super Sale on Fair Entry by Friday before fair. Designation of which animal may be changed before Thursday evening during the week of the fair.
8. Designation whether the animal will ship to market will be required on Fair Entry before the fair. Once signed up to ship, an animal will be required to be shipped.

FAQ's

- Q. Why are only 10 year and/or last year 9 year members allowed to sell live animals?
- A. This allows for those members who have worked hard throughout their 4-H career to be rewarded and highlighted for their accomplishments.
- Q. Why aren't 10 year and/or last year 9 year members allowed to keep 100% of the funds they receive?
- A. This allows for 50% of the funds raised to go directly to the Sale fund which benefits all the 4-Her's signed up. Over a 4-Her's tenure, they will benefit from the giving of previous 10 year 4-Her's.
- Q. Isn't this unfair to the current 10 year and last year 9 year members?
- A. These 4-Her's were allowed in their past years to keep all of the funds from previous live auctions and benefit in ways current younger members will not be.
- Q. What about Add-On's, who keeps this money?
- A. 100% of money that is raised through Add-on's and directed by buyers to a specific 4-Her will be given to that 4-Her and paid directly by the buyer to the 4-Her.
- Q. What is an Add-on?
- A. An Add-on is the opportunity for a specific buyer to give money to a specific 4-Her and support the sale of their animal. Information for buyers to do the Add-on's will be available the week of the fair. The buyer will send a check directly to the 4-Her.
- Q. What about group buyers as in the past or Friends of 4-Her groups?
- A. We would encourage 4-Her's to reach out to those supporters and ask they sign up as individual buyers for the auction and give support as an Add-On. 100% of the money from the Add-On goes straight to the 4-Her designated. This also helps get recognition for that buyer as a supporter and helps them achieve the recognition level as explained in the announcement.
- Q. How will the Super Sale fund be distributed?
- A. The Super Sale fund will be divided equally among all of the 4-Her's signed up for the Super Sale. This includes the 10 year and last year 9 year members that sell a live animal.

Q. When will 4-Her's receive their funds from the Super Sale?

A. These checks will be distributed to the 4-Her's after all proceeds are collected. This is typically within 30 days of the sale.

Q. Do 4-Her's have to be present for the Buyer's Bonanza for the Super Sale?

A. Only 4-H members selling a live animal are required to be present. All other members are selling virtually and are not required to be present, but encouraged to come and meet the buyers and interact.





Q. Do I have to sign up on Fair Entry which animal I am selling?

A. Yes, this will be required and information will be sent out to exhibitors on how to sign up. If a 4-Her wishes to switch which animal is designated as the sale animal later in the week, this may be accomplished by discussing with the Super Sale Director at least 24 hours before the sale.

26. Review your invoice, in either summary format or detail format. If it looks correct, click the green “Continue” box. If not, go back to the entries tab and fix what you need to.
