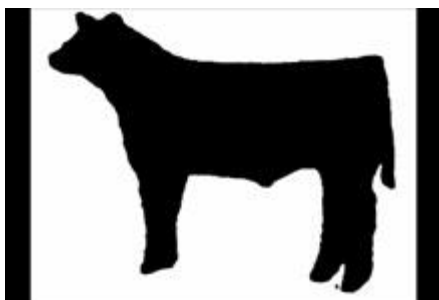
The Hendricks County Beef Cattle Association will offer one or more \$500 scholarship to a qualified Hendricks County student to help further his/her educational goals and to recognize his/her involvement in the beef breed industry.

Criteria for Consideration

1. Must be a Hendricks County resident.
2. Recipient must have been involved in the market beef or breeding beef industry for at least four (4) years out of the last five (5) years. Applicable experience might include the 4-H beef breed project, junior exhibitions, employment at a beef breed farm, or involvement in a family beef breed operation.
3. Recipient is accepted to or currently enrolled in a college, junior college, or trade school.
4. Applications will be entertained from 2025 high school graduates.
5. Candidates will be evaluated and scholarships awarded on the following basis:
 - a. Activities in the beef breed industry
 - b. Involvement in junior beef activities; 4-H and FFA.
 - c. Community activities and involvement.
 - d. Academic achievement.
 - e. Future plans.
6. Candidates may be required to complete an interview before final selection.
7. **NOTE: Everything, including a copy of the transcript, MUST be turned in *by the due date* to be considered for the scholarship.**

Awarding of Scholarships

1. Scholarship winners will be announced and recognized at his/her high school academic awards program and at the Hendricks County 4-H Fair.
2. The Hendricks County Beef Cattle Association will pay the scholarship award directly to the winning student on or before October 1, 2026.
