The Hendricks County Milk Producers congratulate you on completing the 4-H Dairy Project for many years. The HCMP continues to award scholarships for advanced education.

Please Note that the scholarship amount is now up to \$1,000.

Please ensure that your application is thorough and accurate. Only applicants completing all requested information will be considered.

Criteria for Consideration

- Recipients must have been involved in the 4-H Dairy project for at least four (4) years.
 (This does NOT include the Dairy Steer or Dairy Steer Starter Calf project. These are considered under the Beef Scholarship requirements.)
- 2. Recipient is accepted to or currently enrolled in a college, junior college, or trade school.
- 3. Candidates will be evaluated, and scholarships awarded on the following basis:
 - a. Past, current, and future endeavors in the dairy industry
 - b. Involvement in 4-H and/or FFA experiences
 - c. Activities, including community, school and extra-curricular
 - d. Academic achievement
- 4. Candidates may be required to complete an interview before final selection.
- 5. Previous recipients can continue to reapply for scholarships with a maximum of four scholarships available per individual.

Awarding of Scholarships

- 1. Scholarship winners will be announced and recognized at the Hendricks County 4-H Fair or 4-H Achievement Banquet.
- 2. The Hendricks County Milk Producers will pay the scholarship award directly to the selected recipient.
