The deadline for this application is June 1st and must be turned in to the Howard County Extension Office. Selected applicants will be interviewed. Requirements for the scholarship are as follows:

- 1. Must be currently enrolled as a 4-H member in Howard County.
- 2. Must be accepted into a college or training program for the fall semester.
- 3. Must complete the Paul Raver Memorial Scholarship application form.
- 4. Must include two letters of recommendation.

Note: one of the letters must be from someone who can write about your involvement and/or experiences in 4-H. (E.g., 4-H Club Leader, project superintendent, neighbor, 4-H parent, younger 4-H member, etc.)

5. Must submit a copy of your Howard County 4-H Achievement Record Sheet.

Applicants for this scholarship must complete the appropriate application and submit their two letters of recommendation by June 1st to the Howard County Extension Office at 120 E. Mulberry Street, Suite 105, Kokomo. Applications may be obtained from the Howard County Extension Office or from the Howard County Extension website. The recipient of this scholarship will be recognized at the Howard County 4-H Awards Program during the Howard County 4-H Fair. Scholarship money will be given in January of the following year after first semester grades are submitted to the Extension Office.
