Huntington County Royalty Contest Expectations

1. Each contestant must be a current Huntington County 4-H member.
2. Boys and girls who have participated in the 4-H Royalty contest previously and NOT selected Royalty Champion are eligible to compete again.
3. Participants must be at least 16 years old by August 23, 2023.
 - a. To compete in the state fair queen contest you must be at least 18 years of age and not older than 22 years of age as of June 1, 2024.
4. For the Indiana State Fair Queen Pageant, the highest placing female, who meets the state fair requirements, will be eligible to represent Huntington County at the state fair.
5. The Huntington County 4-H Royalty Contest Score Card will be used in judging the contest. Criteria will include:
 - 4-H record (Number years in 4-H, accomplishments in project work, number years Jr Leader, offices held, participation in special activities (Demonstrations, judging, etc.), Other 4-H involvement)
 - Community Involvement
 - 1-2 minute speech
 - Personal interview
 - Impromptu question
 - Business wear
 - Formal wear
6. Entries must be received in the Huntington County Extension Office by the end of office hours on May 15.
7. Must attend 4-H workshops. All workshops will begin at 7:00 on the following dates: May 23rd, June 6th, June 20th, July 10th, July 12th. All dates are subject to change.
8. Business attire expectations:
 - a. Solid black pants or skirt; Solid white top or blouse. Blazer or suit jacket may be added (color of your choice)
9. Formal wear expectations:
 - a. When choosing a formal gown, at least one portion of the hemline must be floor length (touching the floor or contestant's foot). A gown with the skirt split above the knee (more than 2" above the knee), a low-cut bodice and/or cut/design inappropriate for the contest may be discounted by the judges.
10. The contest will be held in the afternoon of July 14th and in the evening. Times to be determined.
- 11. To be eligible for Royalty scholarship and prizes, contestants must complete 20 hours of fair service between the dates of the dog show and ending at fair clean up! The following events are included but not limited to: passing out ribbons at a show, 4-H youth day, and volunteering at the auction.**
