General Guidelines for the Open Class Horticulture Show

- 1. Project drop off will be at the Heartland REMC Stage on Sunday, July 23, 1pm-3:30pm.
- 2. Judging will take place on Sunday, July 23, 4pm.
- 3. Participants are encouraged to remain for judging & will have the opportunity to speak to the judge.
- 4. There will be 2 divisions:
 - -A Senior division will consist of participants 19 years & older.
 - -A Junior/ Senior team division consisting of 1 junior level (age 18 or younger) & 1 senior level.
- 5. Junior/ Senior team and Senior division participants must complete the project card and attach to entry. Common names for all plants used are to be listed.
- 6. A winner will be selected for each of the 5 categories- Succulent or Succulent Garden, Fresh Cut Bouquet, Planter, Wreath, & Fairy Garden, within each of the 2 divisions- Senior & Junior/ Senior team.
- 7. Winning entries in each division, within each category, will be on display at the 4-H fair and may be released on Wednesday, July 26, 5pm.
- 8. All non-winning entries will be released at end of the show.
- 9. There will be NO LIMIT to the number of entries per person.
- 10. No lights permitted as any part of the exhibits.
- 11. The rules specific to each category, are as follows:

Succulent or Succulent Garden:

- 1. Must consist of 1 or more plant
- 2. Container to measure 10" or less (width, length, height).
- 3. Materials to enhance the display are permitted, with the exception of lights, and artificial plants.
- 4. No lights permitted as any part of the exhibits.

Fresh Cut Bouquet:

- 1. Must consist of all fresh materials
- 2. May be displayed in a vase that measures no taller than 12", or wrapped.
- 3. No silk or plastic artificial plant materials to be used.
- 4. No lights permitted as any part of the exhibits.

Planter:

- 1. Must be a live plant or plants
- 2. Plant container may not exceed 18" in each direction.
- 3. Should be an established planting.
- 4. No silk or plastic artificial plant materials to be used.
- 5. No lights permitted as any part of the exhibits.

Wreath:

- 1. Must be either a living or dried, hand-crafted exhibit.
- 2. Any shape is permitted.
- 3. No silk or plastic artificial plant materials to be used.
- 4. No lights permitted as any part of the exhibits.

Fairy Garden:

- 1. Minimum of 3 different plants to be used.
- 2. Entire exhibit may not exceed 18" in each direction.
- 3. Materials to enhance the display are permitted, with the exception of lights, and artificial plants.
- 4. No lights permitted as any part of the exhibits.
