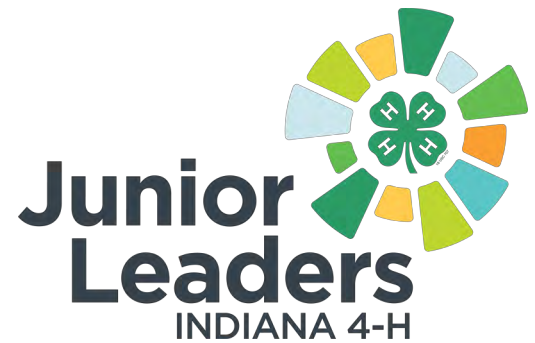

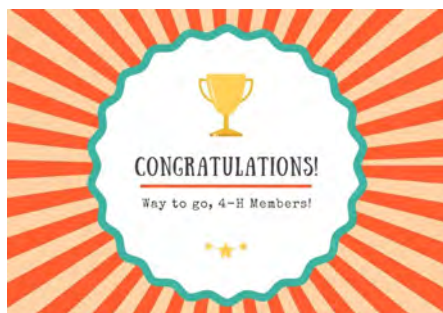

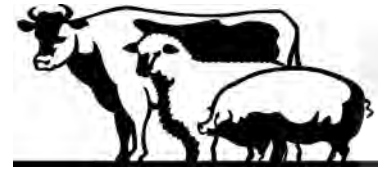

Did You Know?



In March of 2020, we officially established the Jackson County 4-H Endowment!

An interest bearing endowment has been set up with the Indiana 4-H Foundation to benefit the Jackson County 4-H Program for years to come. Currently, there is **\$31,923.63** invested in the account. Only the interest is spent out each year, meaning the funds will support the Jackson County 4-H Program for years to come. This year, we were able to use some of the funds to hire an additional part time summer assistant to assist with fair preparations. Indiana 4-H Foundation's endowment funds are held and invested by the Purdue Research Foundation through a special agreement. This allows us to receive great returns on investments.
