

Dear 2022 Auction Buyer,

This is an information letter about the Jennings County 4-H Livestock Auction on Friday, June 17. Registration begins at 4:30 pm. At the registration table, Buyers will receive a free food voucher to use at the Junior Leaders' food stand. 4-H Awards will start at 5:30 pm with the auction starting at 6:00 pm.

### **Auction Order:**

**Swine, Dairy/Meat Goats, Rabbits, Horse & Pony, Llama, Dairy & Beef, Sheep, & Poultry. At the beginning of each specie, Grand/Res Grand will sell first followed by ten year members, first year members, and then all other members at a random draw.**

1. The Jennings County Livestock Auction will be a PREMIUM only auction. Any 4-H'er who has shown in a market class may present ONE animal of their choice to auction. The winning bidder will pay the bid price.

If the winning bidder wishes to purchase the animal for personal use, the bidder will make arrangements with the 4-H owner directly to purchase the animal. The Jennings County 4-H program will have no involvement in the purchase of these animals. Only the premium bid will be paid to the 4-H'er through the Jennings County 4-H Livestock Committee. An option for the 4-H'er to send the animal to open market will be made available when possible.

2. Again this year, we are going to give buyers the opportunity to pre-register in hopes to make the start of the auction run smoother. Those buyers that pre-register will only have to pick up their buyer number and meal voucher the night of the auction. 3. At the end of the auction, the buyer then reports to the cashier to pay the premium to the Jennings County 4-H Livestock Committee.
