## Wristband Information

Wristbands will be available for pick-up at the Fair Office, located next to the Grandstands, starting June 26th. The Fair Office hours are Monday thru Friday, 8:00am-8:00pm. They will be open, Tuesday, July 4th from 9am-2pm.

All 4-H Members and actively screened Volunteers will receive one (1) free wristband for the week of fair. Volunteers must be completely finished with their enrollment process by June 16, 2023 in order to take advantage of the free wristband offer. No Volunteer names will be added to the list after this date.

Eligible 4-H Parents can purchase a halfpriced wristband for \$20.00 per person.

# **Record of Completion**

Record of Completion forms are required as part of your project completion and are available in the Extension Office or online at https://extension.purdue.edu/county/ kosciusko/

Your Record of Completion form can be turned in anytime during Fair Week at the 4-H Fair Office at the Fairgrounds. In order for a 4-H member to receive achievement points, you must have your Record of Completion form turned in no later than 4:30pm on Monday, July 17th at the Extension Office.

Once the Record of Completion forms have been scored they will be returned to your Club Leader. They will then return them to you at your next club meeting.

It is very important that you keep your Record of Completion forms together year after year. They will come in handy during your 8th, 9th and 10th years in 4-H for the Royalty Contest and Scholarships.

We DO NOT keep copies of the Record of Completion forms in the Extension Office. It is your responsibility to get the forms back from your Club Leader and put them somewhere that you can find them when needed.

# **YQCA**



We have 130 enrolled 4-H members that HAVE NOT 4-H program year. YQCA is a

requirement for all youth (except Mini 4-H) planning to exhibit Swine, Beef Cattle, Dairy Cattle, Dairy Steer, Dairy Feeder Steer, Sheep, Goats, Rabbit or Poultry. YQCA must be completed by June 15th in order to exhibit and sell in the auction. You still have time to complete YQCA by enrolling in an online training session at yqcaprogam.org. 
# 4-H Fair Office
