

Reminders

Please Do Not Skip This Part!

<u>May 15th</u> - Animal Identification is due in 4HOnline by May 15th. Any animals not entered in 4HOnline by this date are NOT ALLOWED to show at the 4-H County or State Fair. Our suggestion is to enter ALL of your animals, just in case.

<u>June 15th</u> - Proof of Completed Youth for the Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) or Indiana 4-H Quality

Livestock Care Certificates (QLC) due. Any member not showing proof of completion by June 15 will NOT BE ALLOWED to show at the 4-H County or State Fair.

<u>June 15th</u> - FairEntry due for General Projects and Animal Projects. On the livestock end, failure to enter your animal(s) in FairEntry by the deadline will result in showing in an Exhibition Class. On the

general projects end, failure to enter your project(s) in Fair Entry by the deadline will result in not placing higher than a Blue Ribbon which also means you cannot advance your project to the Indiana

State Fair.

If you have any questions regarding these deadlines, feel free to contact the Extension Office at 574.372.2340. Don't let any confusion about the deadline implications stop you from showcasing your animal or presenting your project at the 4-H Fair.

4-H Animal Identification

Due May 15, 2024!

ALL animals must be entered by May 15th. Click <u>HERE</u> for instructions on how to enroll your animal. To enroll, go to: <u>https://v2.4honline.com</u>

For Poultry: An Animal Identification paper form must be completed and returned to the Extension Office by MAY 15TH. This date is NEW for 2024. You should have received your form in the mail, but if not, click<u>HERE</u> for one.

For Swine: If you are NOT taking your swine to the 2024 Indiana State Fair, please enter 16 zeros in the RFID Field.

FairEntry

Open May 22, 2024 thru June 15, 2024!

The 2024 Kosciusko County 4-H Fair is quickly approaching! This year, both Kosciusko County and the State of Indiana will be implementing an online enrollment system, called FairEntry, for all 4-H Members to register their exhibits for the upcoming fair. Here are some key details to note:

- FairEntry, an internet-based platform integrated with 4HOnline, is mandatory for all exhibits, including both livestock and non-livestock entries.
- The FairEntry program will be accessible from May 22, 2024, to June 15, 2024, allowing participants to select their livestock classes and specify the animals for exhibition based on their 4HOnline profiles.
- For non-livestock entries (general projects), participants will provide details such as Black & White Salon Print, Sewing Wearing, Foods, Baked goods, and more.
- FairEntry is also used to register non-livestock exhibits for the Indiana State Fair, generate reports for local media, and maintain records of rankings and accolades.

- Mini 4-H Families are encouraged to try FairEntry this year, especially 2nd graders, as it will become mandatory once the 4-H Member enters 3rd grade.

Indiana 4-H QLC Program

All 4-H youth enrolled in a Livestock Project (Beef, Dairy, DCFS/Dairy Beer, Goat, Poultry Rabbit, Sheep and Swine) must be certified in the Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care Program or have a YQCA online completion certificate.

If you choose to complete the YQCA option, you will register for the online course at: <u>https://yqcaprogram.org</u>. The cost of the online YQCA course is \$12. After completing the course, you must email the 4-H Educator (<u>adferrel@purdue.edu</u>) your certificate to receive credit.

If you prefer to take the in-person, instructor-led Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care Program, the cost is \$3 per member (exact change, please) and will be located at the Purdue Extension Office-Kosciusko County at 202 W Main St, Warsaw, Indiana.

This is your last chance to complete the in-person Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care Program training sessions for 2024:

- Thursday, May 16 @ 6pm
 - Please note May 16 is a different date than previously advertised
 - NEW: Location will be Leesburg Methodist Church

Remember, in order to exhibit your Livestock Project at the 2024 Kosciusko County 4-H Fair, you must complete the Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care Program Workshop (or YQCA online). Deadline for completing this is June 15th. If QLC/YQCA is not completed by this date, you will not be eligible for county fair exhibition.

DNA Sample Envelopes

DNA Sample Envelopes are ready and available at the Extension Office. Stop by to get yours soon. DNA is required for State-Bound Swine, Beef or Dairy Beef Cattle, Sheep, Meat Goats & Dairy Cattle. Deadline to turn in DNA Envelopes is May 15, 2024.

Premise IDs are REQUIRED

To engage in buying, selling, or showcasing livestock, individuals must possess a Premise ID. This unique number identifies the physical location where animals are kept, safeguarding animal agriculture and the livestock sector. In times of urgency, swift communication about disease transmission can occur between animal health officials and producers. It is mandatory for all 4-H participants to be aware of their property's Premise ID and to register this number in 4HOnline when enrolling animals for exhibition at the 4-H fair and Indiana State Fair.

If you do not currently have a Premise ID number, you may apply for one through the Indiana State Board of Animal Health at <u>http://www.in.gov/boah/forms/indiana-premises-identification-</u> <u>registration</u>

You must have a premise ID to show at the Kosciusko County 4-H Fair and the Indiana State Fair for cattle, swine, goats and sheep.

Record of Completion

The 4-H program has a long-standing tradition of highlighting the importance of record-keeping as a vital life skill in our daily lives. Completing a 4-H Record of Completion involves documenting

project and club activities in a standardized format.

The main goal of the 4-H Record of Completion is to educate youth on the significance of maintaining records as a valuable life skill that extends beyond a single year.

Objectives of 4-H Record Keeping:

- Develop goal-setting, action planning, and self-assessment skills.
- Acquire record-keeping and organizational skills for present and future applications.
- Improve communication and summarization abilities.
- Foster responsibility through task completion.
- Evaluate information that can showcase personal skills on future resumes and applications.

To obtain a Record of Completion form, visit the Extension Office or access it on our website. Before submitting the form, ensure it is fully completed by the 4-H Member, including signatures from a parent and club leader. Forms can be submitted at the Fair Office on the fairgrounds during the fair week, with a deadline of Monday, July 15th.

Important 4-H Fair information

To ensure a successful 2024 4-H Fair, be sure to do the following:

- Read the 2024 Kosciusko County 4-H Guide Book. We do have a few printed version available in the Extension Office, otherwise find it on our website at: <u>https://extension.purdue.edu/county/kosciusko/4-h.html</u>
- Turn in any forms due by May 15th
 - Lease forms, if applicable
 - Pen forms, if applicable
 - Swine County Bred & Born forms
 - Poultry Forms
 - Cat Enrollment forms
 - Pocket Caged Critter forms
- Make sure you have your vaccination forms for Cat, Dog, Pocket Caged Critters and Horse & Pony
- Be sure you know your project check-in dates and times, available in the Guide Book.

4-H Poster Exhibit Requirements

Failure to adhere to these instructions could lead to a lower exhibit grade:

- Poster board: Posters must measure 22" x 28" unless specified otherwise, and they are not required to be white.
- Labels: 3 x 5.5" labels for posters will be provided by the 4-H office during project check-in to indicate the 4-H member, project, and level. Attach this label to the lower right-hand corner of the poster and adjust your display accordingly.
- Stiff backing: Use materials like foam core board, very stiff cardboard, plywood, or Masonite (1/8" thick) to prevent the poster from bending forward.
- Plastic covering: Clear heavy plastic sleeves are available from the Extension Office for \$.25 each. Avoid using kitchen wrap.
- Citations: Ensure all posters include necessary citations.
- Club Information: Include the 4-H member's name and club printed on the back of the poster.
- Orientation: Display your poster horizontally, similar to a dollar bill.


