Whether it's your first year in 4-H or your tenth, every season brings new opportunities to support your child's growth—not just in their project, but as a confident, capable young person. Here's a simple behind-the-scenes guide to help you stay organized, stay sane, and enjoy the journey!

## Fall: The Fresh Start

- Get Enrolled Make sure your child is enrolled in 4HOnline and projects are selected correctly.
- Connect with Leaders Attend club kick-off meetings and ask questions early.
- Organize Supplies Make a checklist for project supplies, record sheets, and other materials.
- Mark the Calendar Put key deadlines, club meetings, and livestock tag-ins on your family calendar now.
- Ask About Scholarships or Fundraisers Great time to plan ahead for camp or project costs.

### Winter: Planning Season

- Check Project Guidelines Review requirements in the handbook or website for each chosen project.
- Start Small Tasks Begin record sheets, make early purchases, and plan learning activities.
- Livestock Families Check housing, feed plans, and make appointments for vaccinations or breeding.
- Encourage Independence Let kids make choices and try things—even if it means mistakes. That's growth!
- Stay in the Loop Follow your Extension office and club's social media or newsletters for updates.

# Spring: Crunch Time

- Watch Deadlines FairEntry, YQCA, workshop sign-ups, and project drop/add dates come fast.
- Check Tags & IDs Livestock ID needs to be accurate and submitted on time.
- Project Progress Help your child pace themselves and make to-do lists, but avoid taking over.
- Practice Showmanship or Public Speaking Confidence comes from preparation.

## Summer: Showtime!

- Fair Week Prep Pack smart (include extras!), label everything, and print schedules.
- Keep a Cooler Packed Snacks, water, and wipes will save the day more than once.
- Support, Don't Stress The best words on show day? "I'm proud of you no matter what."
- Celebrate All Successes A completed project is an achievement, regardless of the ribbon color.
- Pitch In Where You Can Help at clean-up, volunteer at events, and set a great example.
