% TOPS IN 4-H **%**

Tops in 4-H is a recognition for outstanding 10th, 11th, and 12th grade 4-H members. Selection is based on accumulated points in their 4-H record of achievement forms.

Candidates MUST submit their records to the Office by:

MAY 15, 2024

Candidates must:

- 1. Must be a Sophomore as of Jan 1
- 2. An active member of a local 4-H Club
- 3. Submit completed Records
- 4. Be available for interviews, newspaper photos, and other publicity
- 5. Volunteer as a host for at least 1 fair event or show
- 6.Conduct themselves in accordance with 4-H behavioral expectations
- 7. Promote 4-H to younger members
- 8.Be present at 4-H Fair opening ceremonies and participate in the parade



If you took the YQCA Class Online last year after June 24, 2023

You will **NEED** to take a QLC class this year!

The YQCA class can only be taken once in a year, so you will not be eligible to take it online again till after June 24, 2024

4-H ONLINE ANIMAL ID AND PROJECT DEADLINE: MAY 15



WHAT'S REQUIRED TO BE ENTERED INTO 4-H ONLINE?

- All Static Projects: these are your non-animal projects
- Small Animals This includes dogs, cats, rabbits, and poultry You do not need to add individual animals at this point; just sign up for the project.
- Large Animals This is ALL other animals- You must enter each animal eligible for 4-H into 4-H Online.
- You will NEED the Premise ID number for where the ANIMALS live if you have animals that live at the same address as you and others that live somewhere else, you will need two Premise ID numbers; Premise ID is associated with addresses
- Beef, Dairy Beef, Dairy Goat, Meat Goat, Sheep, and Swine—You are required to have identification via one or more of the following tattoos, county tags, RFID/840 tags, or ear notches.
- Prospect (Baby) Beef those you are using as your auction animal -will need to be identified via an RFID/840 or county tag. You can pick these up at the office or purchase your own.
- Horse & Pony and Draft Horse You will need to enter your animals into 4-H
 Online as well but will also need 2 pictures from each side of your animal,
 including the face and all 4 feet. You will also need to upload your vaccination
 papers/form.
- If you are leasing an animal, be sure to fill out the lease agreement; there is a place to upload it to 4-H Online as well.
- STATE FAIR BOUND? Be sure to get your animals' Hair Samples into the Extension Office by MAY 15!!! The office has the forms and envelopes you need to collect the samples.
- The animals you enter into 4-H Online will transfer to FairEntry. In FairEntry, you will be able to place those animals into the appropriate classes for the livestock shows.

QLC / YQCA : JUNE 24

IMPORTANT INFORMATION: NOT COMPLETING FAIRENTRY BY JUNE 24, 2024 WILL RESULT IN NO HIGHER THAN A BLUE RIBBON FOR STATIC PROJECTS AND BEING PLACED IN AN EXHIBITION ONLY CLASS (WILL NOT RECEIVE A PLACING) WITH LIVESTOCK PROJECTS.



Animal Identification

4-H members (Grades 3-12) must identify all Beef and Dairy Cattle, Goats, Horses, Llamas, Sheep and Swine in the 4-H Online system by the species deadline or earlier county deadline if applicable to be eligible for exhibition.

•Beef and Dairy Beef Steers, Beef Heifers, Beef/Dairy Feeder Calves, Dairy Cattle, Goats, Horses, Llamas, Sheep, and Swine must be entered into 4-H Online no later than May 15, 2023.


Please complete the following steps to identify your livestock in the 4-H Online system.

1.Login to your family profile at: https://v2.4honline.com using your family email address and password associated with your 4-H enrollment record.


a.If you have forgotten your password, please use the 'Reset password' option on the 4-H Online login page, and you will be sent a new temporary password.

b.If you have forgotten your family email address or turned in a paper 4-H enrollment form, please contact your local Purdue Extension Office for assistance.

2. Click View next to the Member's record for whom you would like to add an animal


5.Click on "Add New Animal" to start adding a new animal or if you have animals that carry over from the previous year you "Register" those. Animals that can be registered from previous years must be REGISTERED every year by

completing this step. You cannot select a previous year and assume they are there. Animals that carry over are Dairy Cattle Females, Horse&Pony, Llama&Alpaca, Dairy Goat

Females, and Pygmy Goats (move onto step 9 if registering previous animal).

6.Select the appropriate animal type from the drop-down menu.
7.Enter the required Tag, Tattoo, or Animal Name as directed for the first step that will then allow you to proceed to the remaining identification process. (see Key)

8.Click Save.

- 9.Read the on-screen instructions for Animal ID requirements for County Fair and Indiana State Fair Exhibition.
- 10.Click on the button "Show Questions" after reading the instructions.
- 11. Required fields are indicated, but be sure to complete all other visible fields as applicable.
- 12.Click next once completed. If animals have been carried over, the ID information will already be there.
- 13.Upload any files if required or necessary for the particular Animal type. For animals that are carried over, new photos and files must be uploaded each year.
- 14.Click next once completed.
- 15.Review the entered information. Use the Back button at the bottom of the page to return to the previous screen to make corrections if needed.
- 16.Once the entered information is correct and reviewed, click the Submit button.
- 17. The animal information will display on the screen with the status, created, modified, and submitted date and time stamp (local time). You will also receive a confirmation email upon submission.
- 18.To add more animals for the same member repeat steps 3-17. To add animals for another member return to the Member List and View another member.

Note Members are able to edit Animal ID information until the species specific Animal ID deadline of May 15, 2023. Click on the Animals tab from your account at any time to view the status for all of the animals for a member in the family.

Family Enrollment of Animals

Animals are automatically co-enrolled within the same family (Siblings and step-siblings). The animals may be identified under a single 4-H member in 4-H Online and be exhibited by a different sibling listed in the same family profile. With this capability in 4-H Online, animals do not need to be entered under each 4-H member in the family. The exhibit management program will allow a member to select to exhibit any animal identified by the family in 4-H Online. It is suggested that at least 1 animal be identified by each member enrolled in the project.
