4-H Enrollment (October 1-January 15)

- Enrollment starts October 1st on 4–H Online website https://v2.4honline.com/. The enrollment form is how we know who is participating in 4–H and that parents have given permission for youth to participate. It tells us how to reach you, so that the office and 4–H leaders can communicate with you. It also tells us which projects you are interested in, so we can share information about workshops, rule changes, etc. Families can log back in and edit this as needed throughout the year, so please keep your information current.
- If you were enrolled in 4-H last year, do not try to create a new account! Just log in to your existing family profile and update your information as needed. You can reset your password if you have forgotten it.

Indiana 4-H Program Fees

- Payment can be made online by credit/debit card or by submitting a cash or check payment to the Extension Office within ten days of online registration.
 Please make checks payable to Purdue University.
- There is no fee for Mini 4-H (grades K-2). For members in grades 3-12, the program fee is \$15.00.

Most of our 4-H clubs meet at least once a month. If you don't know when your next club meeting is, please contact your club leader. If you don't know who your club leader is, contact the Extension Office at (219) 755-3240 and we will be happy to help!

What if someone wants to join after January 15th? They are welcome! Returning members and adult volunteers need to re-enroll by January 15th or their records will be archived. No internet access? You are welcome to enroll at the Extension Office. Paper forms are also available.

• While memories of the past 4-H year are fresh, it's a good time to make and submit a 4-H Memory Book. The guidelines are in the Lake County 4-H Handbook and each 4-H member can complete a book each year that they are members. This is an excellent opportunity for 4-Hers to take a look at their goals and achievements of the past year and for future years. It is an organized way to recall and record your many successes and favorite time of the past year. Every participant will receive an activity ribbon if they meet the requirements. The books are due in the Extension Office by November 1.
