- 2. Individual must be intending on pursuing a degree at a college or university or tech school.
- 3. The individual must have at least a C grade point average at the time of application. Please provide a transcript of your grades with the application.
- 4. ENTIRE application must be thoroughly completed before being submitted (all essay questions fulfill required word count).
- 5. Application must be typed; no handwritten responses will be eligible for consideration.
- 6. Completed applications must be postmarked by June 15th and mailed to the LaPorte County Ext. Office at: 2857 W. State Road 2, Suite A LaPorte, IN 46350 Attention: Beef Scholarship
- 7. Conduct an interview with the 4-H Beef Committee on current issues facing the cattle industry. The interview will be conducted by the selection committee only if it is deemed necessary to choose between candidates.
- 8. Awards will be paid directly to recipient upon proof of enrollment and proof of completion of your first semester of college or tech school.
