1. With the completion of this year, applicant must have been in LaPorte County 4-H Beef Project for a total of five (5) years.
2. Individual must be pursuing a degree at a college, university or trade school.
3. Applicant must have at least a C grade point average at the time of application. Please provide a transcript of your grades with this application.
4. Entire application must be thoroughly completed before being submitted.
5. All applications must be typed; no hand written responses will be eligible for consideration.
6. Completed applications must be in the Extension Office no later than 3:59pm on Friday, May 29th. LaPorte County Ext. Office: 2857 W St. Rd 2 Suite A, LaPorte, IN 46350.

This award will be paid directly to the recipient upon proof of enrollment and proof of completion of your first semester in college or trade school.
