


4-H ONLINE LIVESTOCK ID

It is never too early to ID your animal in 4-H Online. If you have your animals or you are bringing an animal you brought last year you can enter them in 4-H Online NOW!

Horses, ponies, mini equine, draft horses, and pygmy goats can be reactivated if you plan to bring them to fair again this year. Even if you are not, it never hurts to have extra animals enrolled.

If you have registered animals that do not have to come to tag in day those can be entered now too!

2025 FAIR JUDGING

Judging for Exhibit Hall projects will follow a hybrid format. What does hybrid judging entail? The day will kick off with project check-in, where 4-H members will drop off their projects at the designated judging table. Once check-in is complete, the building will be closed, and all 4-H members and their families will be asked to exit. Judges will then have approximately 1.5 hours to evaluate the projects. Later in the afternoon, 4-H members will have the chance to meet with the judges for a project review, should they choose to participate.
