

Make sure to reactivate them, they will show up in your 4-H Online profile but are not technically entered until you submit them. We will have a 4-H Online help night, May 9th at the Extension Office from 4-6:30 PM if you need help entering animals or solidifying project choices.

<u>Vaccination forms</u> are required for <u>Horse & Pony</u> (including Mini Equine & Draft Horse), <u>Cat</u>, and <u>Dogs</u>

Lease agreements are available at the office and need to be signed by both lessor and lessee

Horse & Pony: Your manuals are due in June. Stall Reservations are due May 15th this year because of the changing of barns.

#### Richard "Dick" Reel Memorial Scholarship
