Most judging will be taking place on June 25th & 26th in the 4-H Exhibit Hall. Make sure to check the full schedule for exact project judging dates. Please remember that Judging is open, only 4-H members may talk to the judge, listen to comments and ask questions.

Building projects will be released during the specified time above. Unauthorized early removal of exhibits will result in the forfeiture of all ribbons, trophies, and honors. All projects will be repurposed or recycled 2 weeks after their release with the exception of State Fair Projects. Those with State Fair projects will be given a date once projects are picked up from State Fair.
