- Provide meals for between 250 people per camp group.
- Assist with camp set up and clean up, including proper cleaning of all kitchen appliances, utensils, and facilities.
- Assists with planning, directing and supervising the activities of the kitchen.
- Assists with implementing correct procedures for food receiving and storage, food handling and distribution.
- Assists with food and supplies from storage areas, to meet daily menu requirements.
- Insures that sanitation, housekeeping, and safety standards meet the requirements of applicable federal, state and local rules and regulations in the kitchen and dining room area.
- Assists with the coordination of all meal planning and food preparation for breakfast, lunch and dinner.
- Helps with assuring that food will not be prepared too far in advance and that the meal schedules will be met.
- Helps to check food service for portion control, serving temperatures, food quality, and sanitary procedures.
- Responsible for Kitchen Laundry.
- Assists wherever needed with kitchen duties.
- Insures that sanitation, housekeeping, and safety standards meet the requirements of applicable federal, state and local rules and regulations in the kitchen and dining room area.
