Dear Consumer Clothing Project Member,

The Consumer Clothing project consists of the private judging, as well as a public Fashion Revue. Private judging for the Consumer Clothing project will be held on **Tuesday, July 8th, at the Montgomery County 4-H Building on 400 Parke Ave., Crawfordsville, IN 47933**. Please look for signage to direct you to check in area. Mothers can help the 4-H'er get dressed and will be able to watch the actual judging. Check-in will begin at 9:00 a.m. and judging will begin at 10:00 a.m.; the order will be Beginners, Intermediate, and Advanced. 4-H'ers will be dismissed after their division has been judged. Be sure to take all your belongings with you when you leave the building.

Please bring the following with you on Tuesday, July 8th:

- The Consumer Clothing Fashion Show Information Sheet is attached to this e-mail. Please fill it out before you arrive. The narrator of the public show will use this information.
- Bring a 4"x6" unmounted picture of yourself wearing the outfit that you will be modeling. Your name and division must be on the back of the picture. This picture is in addition to the ones required for your notebook. It will be used for display at the fair.
- Consumer Clothing Notebook ready to be judged. Please do NOT include prior years(s) information.
- The outfit and accessories ready to be modeled.
- Your orange Project Completion Card - it is required to check-in each of your projects. You should receive this card from your 4-H Club Leader once you show them your signed project record sheet(s). It is your responsibility to enter your placings in your green book. You will keep your green record book after showing it to your 4-H Club Leader.

You may take your garments home after judging. Your notebook will be on exhibit.

The **public Fashion Revue is Saturday, July 12th, at 5:30 p.m. in the 4-H Building**. Awards will be presented at the end of the Public Fashion Revue show. Please wear your outfit from home and take it home with you after the show. If you are selected for Honor Group there will be pictures taken following the program.

Special note regarding Indiana State Fair – In addition to one beginner, intermediate, and advanced consumer clothing state fair entries submitting their notebook for evaluation, the 4-H member will also be invited to model their purchased outfit in Fashion Revue. The notebook and modeling will be judge independently and one will not have any consideration for the other at state fair.
