



## 2026 Smith Family 4-H Sheep Scholarship

### Open to:

- High School Seniors pursuing secondary education
- Must be current, active, Sheep Project Members
- Must have completed at least 6 years in 4-H,
- Must have completed at least 6 years in the Sheep Project
- Must have physically exhibited sheep for no less than 5 years (1 year of alternate exhibition of the 6-year project minimum is acceptable)

### To apply:

- Submit an essay explaining how you got started in the sheep project, where you are today with your sheep and how you got there, how the sheep project has impacted you and what you have learned along the way.

### Include with your essay:

- Your Name
- Address
- Years in 4-H
  - 4-H Club
- Years in the Sheep Project
  - Years exhibiting sheep
  - Years completing posters
- High School attended
- College you will attend

### Deadline: June 17th, 2026:

- Submit your essay to the Montgomery County Extension Office on or before June 17th, 2026.
- If submitted via US Mail, it must be postmarked before June 17th, 2026.

## Smith Family 4-H Sheep Scholarship By-laws

**Annual Scholarship:** 1 @ \$1,000 (or 2 @ \$500 if committee so chooses) payable to the 4-Her & School of Choice.

**Selection Committee:** Montgomery County Sheep Association President & Treasurer, and 2 members of the Montgomery County 4-H Inc. Board.

### Open to:

- High School Seniors pursuing secondary education
- Must be current, active, Sheep Project Members
- Must have completed at least 6 years in 4-H,
- Must have completed at least 6 years in the Sheep Project
- Must have physically exhibited sheep for no less than 5 years (1 year of alternate exhibition of the 6-year project minimum is acceptable)

### To Apply:

- 4-Her must submit an essay explaining:
  - How they got started in the sheep project
  - Where they are today with their sheep and how they got there
  - How the sheep project has impacted them and what they have learned along the way.

### Essays must also include:

- 4-Her Name
- Address
- Years in 4-H
  - 4-H Club
- Years in the Sheep Project
  - Years exhibiting sheep
  - Years completing posters
- High School attended
- College they will attend

**Scholarship Awarded:** at 4-H Awards Program

**Deadline to apply:** No less than 2 weeks before the Awards Program

- Submit essays to the Montgomery County Extension Office on or before Deadline.
- If submitting via US Mail, it must be postmarked *before DEADLINE*.
