4-H Incorporated Board Member Information

As a 4-H Incorporated Board member, you are required to chair either a Standing Committee or Special Committee. We encourage you to recruit committee members from non-board members. A short description of each committee is below.

Special Committees

- Livestock Committee: Line of communication between 4-H Incorporated Board and Species superintendents. Assist with Species meetings throughout the year, workshops, informational meetings, etc.
- Exhibit Hall: In charge of project set-up, supervision of building throughout fair, judge selection, etc.
- 4-H Building: In charge of project set-up, coordinate with Queen Contest chair, coordinate with volunteers for various 4-H events, supervision of building throughout fair, judge selection, etc.
- Safety/Security/Trash: Coordinate fire lane, parking, security, and daily cleanup of fairgrounds during fair.
- Arena & Equipment: In charge of set-up, organization, and cleanliness of Show Arena
- Livestock Auction: Coordinates and sets up the annual livestock auction, as well as coordinates buyers.
- Special Events/Fair Lot Rental (3 Chairs): Tasked with recruiting and securing entertainment and vendors of 4-H Fair. Also responsible for collecting rental monies from vendors and organizing set-up of vendors.
- Consignment Auction: Coordinates with local auctioneers to organize consignments for annual 4-H Consignment Auction. Also serves as the communication between the 4-H Incorporated Board and the Tractor Pull committee.
- Marketing & Advertising: Promote and advertise for the 4-H Fair. Works closely with Fair Lot Rental/Special Events/Food Stand to organize Fair schedule.

Standing Committees

- Budget & Finance Committee: Defaults to 4-H Incorporated Board treasurer.
 Organizes budget for committees and assists with 4-H Club audits.
- Grounds & Future Planning: Coordinates capital improvements and the future of the grounds.
- Nominating Committee: Responsible for recruitment, organizing, and leading the 4-H Incorporated board nominations.
- Awards Committee: Organizes and coordinates project, membership, and special Awards during the 4-H Fair.
- Buildings & Grounds/Maintenance & Upkeep Committee: Oversees the whole grounds throughout the year, insurance, capital improvements, and restoration and maintenance.
- o **Fundraising**: Generate innovative ways to raise monies for general operation.
