It is time already to start thinking about the 2024 4-H Camp! Montgomery County will be camping with Boone, Hendricks, and Tipton counties. The dates for this year's 4-H Camp are **June 6-8** at Shakamak State Park. As a 4-Her in high school you have the opportunity to participate in 4-H Camp as a 4-H Camp Counselor.

Attached to this e-mail is an application to be a 4-H Camp Counselor. In order to be a 4-H Camp Counselor you **MUST** be in grades 9-12 and show past or potential leadership skills. If you are interested in becoming a counselor, please complete the Camp Counselor 2024 application and return it to the Montgomery County Extension office by **Friday, March 22<sup>nd</sup>**. 4-H Camp Counselors are selected based on their leadership, communication, and teamwork skills. Please be sure that your application reflects any past or current experiences that would show why you should be selected as a 4-H Camp Counselor.

Camp Counselors have four trainings to help prepare them for their time at camp. All trainings are held at the Boone County 4-H Fairgrounds (in the Farm Bureau Community Building). Transportation is not provided to the trainings, but is provided to 4-H Camp. In order to be a camp counselor, you **MUST** attend at least three 4-H Camp Counselor trainings. However, I would prefer camp counselors attend all training dates.

**May 6<sup>th</sup> – 7:00-9:00 pm**

**May 21<sup>st</sup> – 7:00-9:00 pm**

4-H Camp Counselor applications are due to the Montgomery County Extension office by **Friday, March 22<sup>nd</sup>**! Late applications will not be considered.
