
Where Do I Place My Exhibit Tag?

All Posters, Notebooks (including Home Environment), Fine Arts, and Other Similar Displays

Securely tape to the bottom right-hand corner, on the outside of any plastic covering. Tags
must be on the OUTSIDE of the plastic sleeve so award stickers may be placed on tag after
judging.



Foods and Food Preservation

- Securely tape to the **outside** of the Ziploc bag or other plastic covering/box.
- If the exhibit is frozen, cover the tag with plastic wrap and use a rubber band to secure tag to exhibit. The judge will remove the tag during judging if needed.

Sewing

- Use a straight pin to fasten the exhibit tag to the left shoulder or left waistband of the garment.
- For non-wearables, pin the tag at the bottom right hand corner or other easily visible spot for display. The judge will remove the tag during judging as needed.

<u>Gardening</u>

• Bring loose tag(s) with exhibit(s) to check-in. Tag(s) will be attached to the provided plate(s) for you.

Floriculture

Securely tape the tag to the exhibit or hole-punch the tag and tie to the vase, etc.

<u>Arts & Crafts (General), Construction & Architectural Replica, Electricity, Fine Arts, Model Craft, Needlecraft, Woodworking, and Others Not Listed:</u>

• Securely fasten the tag in an easy-to-see location on the exhibit for display during the fair. You may also hole-punch the exhibit tag and tie to the project.
