## JUNIOR LEADERSHIP

Objective: Junior Leaders allows youth to take on more of a leadership role, while making a difference in their community.

State Fair: No exhibit

- 1. A 4-H member who is in the 7th grade thru 12th grade at the time of 4-H enrollment will meet the age requirements for Junior Leadership. A Junior Leader must carry and complete one project other than Junior Leadership during the current year.
- 2. Application for membership must be in the Extension Office by the April 1st.
- 3. To be eligible for Junior Leader perks, such as the yearly t-shirt, senior year scholarships, or other awards and recognition members must attend:
  - a. Minimum of 1 in person Junior Leader meeting per year.
  - b. Volunteer at least 1 Junior Leader sponsored event BEFORE fair (Clean ups, charity event, mini-camp, parade scheduled work time) per year.
  - c. Volunteer at 1 approved event DURING fair (static project set-up, static project judging, livestock event you are not competing in, ice cream cabin, kids' day activities, Extension office support) per fair as a JUNIOR LEADER not overlapping with another club or event volunteering.
  - d. Must participate in 1 fund raising event (no minimum dollar amount required, just some form of participation) per year.
- 4. Scholarship requirements:
  - Forms filled out and turned into Junior Leader Coordinators by May 15th.
  - College or Trade School enrollment not required to be awarded.
  - Amount of scholarship based on participation and committee discretion and funds available
