

#### **2024 Noble County 4-H Fair Entry Instructions**



A few notes to help you avoid common problems before you start:

- Once you hit submit, you will not be able to enter any more projects until those first ones have been approved by the Extension Office. Many people click "submit" after their first child only to find out that they can't add anything for the second child until the Extension Office approves the first child's entries. Please read step 9 below carefully to avoid this problem.
- If Fair Entry won't let you click "Submit" at the end, it usually means you've forgotten to fill something out (ex: did you select a club? Did you select an animal for your livestock project?)
- Make sure to continue through the end of the process. You are not done with Fair Entry until you click "Submit". You will receive a confirmation email to let you know it went through.
- 1. Go to <a href="https://bit.ly/2024Noblecountyfairentry">https://bit.ly/2024Noblecountyfairentry</a> or go to Fairentry.com and find your fair.
- 2. Click the green box that says "Sign in with 4-H Online"
- 3. Sign in using your 4-HOnline email and password. DO NOT CREATE A NEW ACCOUNT. We can help you if you have forgotten your email and or password, just call 260-636-2111.
- 4. Click "Create Invoice" or "Begin Work on a New Invoice" (depending on if it is your first time creating an invoice this year)
- 5. Next to the member's name you're putting entries in for, click "Create Entry"
- \* If you do not see a member's name, stop and call the Extension Office.
- 6. Select the correct department, division and class for the entry
- 7. Select the 4-H Club associated with this entry
- 8. If it is a livestock project, select your animal by choosing "Add Animal"
- · Most will now select "choose an existing animal record" EXCEPT for poultry entries. When entering poultry, select "Enter a New Animal Record" · Add the animal you wish to exhibit in the appropriate class for that animal
- 9. In the next screen you will have three choices:
- · "Add another Entry" click this if you need to add more entries for this same member
- · "Register Another Exhibitor" click this if you have entries to add for a different member
- "Continue to Payment" click this only if you have no other entries to add for any family members
- 10. After clicking "Continue to Payment" you will see a total cost of \$0. Click Continue
- 11. You will see "no payment method is necessary" since the cost is \$0. Click Continue
- 12. Click Submit
- 13. You will get an email verification that your entries have been submitted and another email verification once your entries have been approved by the Extension Office.

Once you've completed the Fair Entry process, you may discover that you've entered something incorrectly, or that changes need to be made. Please contact the Extension Office BEFORE July 3rd, to make any changes. This will help the check-in process to run smoothly. Must be registered in Fair Entry or you will show as exhibition only and not eligible for State Fair.

## **General Project Reminders and Extension Office Tips**

- Poster Labels- See Handbook for instructions, you will make your own labels.
- We have poser sleeves available for \$0.50 All 3 sizes. The sleeves are also good to protect other projects.
- Project Labels please include your name and project category somewhere on the project, make your own.
- As long as you did your Fair Entry, we will provide you with printed exhibit display cards at check in. PLEASE DOUBLE CHECK YOUR ENTRIES!
- If you did not do Fair Entry by July 3rd your display card will say EXHIBIT
   ONLY and will not be eligible for State Fair.
- Awards night is Friday July 12th at 6pm. Please make sure your livestock leaders and other clubs are aware if you are attending their additional 10year events during fair. (Livestock Hall of Fame is still during Round Robin)
- The Extension Office will not be able to give out Static Project Results or Livestock Show Results by phone the day of judging. Please have family members contact 4-H'ers after judging to share results.

# **Noble County 4-H Livestock Reminders:**

#### **I4HQLC or YQCA**

- Must be completed to compete by June 23rd for; Beef, Dairy Cattle, Swine, Sheep, Meat Goat, Dairy Goat, Poultry, & Rabbits.
- If you did the class in-person with Noble County you will pick up certificates at fair.
- If you did them in another county or online with YQCA we need you to give us a copy of them by June 23rd.

<u>Fair Entry</u> must be done by July 3rd or you will be Exhibition only. Its better to over enter and scratch than to miss one, put them all in. This is a State Requirement now.

Double check <u>Auction</u> rules and make sure to let them know at check in if you plan to Auction. Can make changes up to 1 hour after the livestock show you are in

#### **Auction Reminders:**

Members must declare at animal check in, which animal will be auctioned.

A posting of livestock entries by member will be posted in the barns prior to show. **PLEASE REVIEW THE LIST**. Confirmation and/or changes are to be made with the Livestock Superintendent within 1 hour after their respective show to make sure they are included in the 4-H Sale Order.

Scratching an animal from the 4-H Sale Order can be done up to 2 hours before the 4-H Auction.

No animal(s) will be added, or changes made to the auction list after 1:00pm on Thursday July 18th evening.

The auction accounts take considerable time to process. We will contact you when check are available. We will be temporarily short staffed in the Extension office and check processing will take longer than usual. Please be patient.

All sale checks will be void after 60 days and money will be sent to Indiana Unclaimed. It will become the responsibility of the 4-H member to claim their money.





Each Noble County 4-H barn species is invited to participate in the Noble County Farm Bureau 4-H Species on Display Competition. This competition was developed by the Noble County Farm Bureau, in coordination with a Noble County 4-H, to utilize the expertise of the 4-H members and volunteers to educate the public on their represented specie.

This year's theme is, "Origin & Purpose." We are looking for simple displays that are easy for the public to understand. Your display should thoroughly explain where your specie originated from and the purpose of that said specie. When designing your display, please take into consideration that the public has no idea about your species. Please gear your display to people of all ages. Remember to include visuals to make your display more interactive!

Each species that creates an informational display will receive \$150.00 from Noble County Farm Bureau. The displays will be judged, and the winning display will receive the remainder of the budged amount. We ask that a representative of the winning species be present at the Round Robin competition to receive the check and get a picture. The money can be used to benefit that specific barn/species project, as determined by that barn superintendent and associated species committee.


