INDIANA 4-H QUALITY LIVESTOCK CARE



To exhibit beef cattle, dairy cattle, swine, sheep, meat goats, dairy goats, poultry, and rabbits, 4-H members must be certified through the Indiana 4-H Quality Livestock Care Program or the Youth for the Quality Care of Animals

Indiana 4-H will still accept YQCA certification for our county and state fair. 4-H members may choose to continue to complete YQCA as it may be required for some livestock shows. Members who wish to complete YQCA will only be allowed to complete the online version. No in-person meetings of YQCA will be held.

BEEF ID DAY: MARCH 18TH, 9-11 AM (DATE CHANGE)

ATTENTION BEEF EXHIBITORS: Beef ID Day will be held at the fairgrounds on February 18th from 9 am-11 am. Market Beef animals will be weighed and tagged. Any cattle who do not attend the ID Day will not be eligible for a rate of gain awards. Any steers not enrolled in 4Honline by May 15th will not be eligible to show at the county or state fair.

Who Attends: Steers, Dairy Beef Steers, Commercial Heifers, Crossbred Heifers

- · ID Information for Steers is due in 4Honline by May 15th.
- · ID Information for Commercial and Market Heifers, Registered Heifers and Dairy Cattle are due in 4Honline by May 15th.
