Non-Livestock Awards

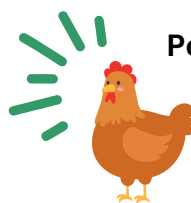
There will be a small ceremony July 2nd at 2:00pm for those who receive a Grand or Reserve Grand Champion non-livestock placing.
