Putnam County Master Gardener Association Scholarship Application for High School Seniors

Putnam County Master Gardeners are committed to sustainable gardening, soil health, environmental soundness, and community involvement. We support education and outreach to local growers of food, flowers, shrubs, and trees. In offering this scholarship, we hope to further the education of young people who share our values.

This \$1,000 scholarship is available to a Putnam County high school senior who is preparing to enter post-secondary education in the fall of 2023. Homeschooled students are welcome to apply. To qualify, the student must:

- Have a grade point average of 2.5 or higher;
- Plan to major in horticulture, agriculture, plant science, botany, forestry, landscape architecture/design, or another gardening-related field;
- Include a letter of recommendation from a teacher who has taught this student within the last two years;
- Include a transcript listing courses taken and grades received, for seven semesters;
- Be accepted into an accredited two- or four-year college or university and be enrolled for the fall of 2023.

This application must be postmarked or emailed on or before April 3, 2023.
