

### The Recipe Corner

Southwestern

Pasta Salad

#### **Ingredients:**

- 2 Ears Corn, shucked
- 1 Box Medium Shell Pasta
- 3/4 Cup Sour Cream
- 3/4 Cup Mayonnaise
- 1 Packet Ranch Seasoning Mix
- 1 Tbsp. Lime Juice
- 1/2 Tsp. Ground Cumin
- 1 Pack of Cherry Tomatoes, halved
- 1 Can Pinto Beans, drained
- 2 Avocados, diced
- 1 Bell Pepper, chopped
- 1/2 Red Onion, chopped
- 1 Cup Shredded Mexican Cheese Blend

Servings: 8-10

#### **Instructions:**

- 1.) Boil a large pot of water, then boil corn until tender. Remove the corn and rinse with cold water to cool.
- 2.) Next, put your pasta in the same boiling water, once tender drain pasta, rinse, and let cool.
- 3.) Blend together the sour cream, mayo, ranch seasoning, lime juice, and cumin.

- 4.) Cut the corn off the cobs. Then, in a large bowl combine your corn, cooled pasta, tomatoes, beans, avocado, bell pepper, onion, and cheese.
- 5. Once combined, fold in the dressing. Let that all chill and Enjoy!!
