*If you are planning to exhibit Meat Pen ducks and pullets to the fair, you should be thinking about getting them soon.


Animal ID Day

Animal Entry on 4-H Online

If your 4-Her is exhibiting an animal at the fair, they must have their animals **registered in 4-H Online by May 15th** or they will be unable to show that animal. If you need assistance with this process, please come into the office or call by May 12th!

State Fair Animal Requirements

In addition to the other state fair requirements, every animal that goes to State Fair must have a DNA sample on file with the local extension office. Please call the office @ 812-689-6511 with any questions or concerns. Getting these samples to the office yourselves or via ID days, is your 4-Her's responsibility. We will not be able to contact every family that is missing certain animal requirements.

Quality Care of Animals Program

To exhibit **beef cattle**, **dairy cattle**, **swine**, **sheep**, **meat goats**, **dairy goats**, **poultry and rabbits at the Ripley County Fair**, 4-H members must be certified through the Indiana 4-H Livestock Quality Care training. Quality Assurance training must be completed by 4-H members annually. In person training will be available at Ripley County. You do not need to register before hand, but must complete one training to exhibit your animals or be eligible for the 4-H auction. Training dates are:

May 6, 2023 (ID day) at 10:00AM in Homemaker's building

July 15, 2023 (barn set up) at 10:00AM

If you cannot attend either of these dates, you can still complete the online Youth Quality Care of Animals (YQCA) program. There is a cost of \$12 and you must print and bring a copy of your certificate to the office. Please call the office with questions.

If you still need to enroll, log into your new or existing 4-H account through https://v2.4honline.com and sign up today! Enrolled 4-Hers can


also still add static/ exhibit hall project as well. **If you have not paid for enrollment you need to do so ASAP.** You will not be able to complete projects for the Fair without doing so.


