What is 4-H?

4-H is a community of young people across America who are learning leadership, citizenship and life skills. 4-H youth programs provide opportunities for youth to develop skills they can use now and throughout their life.

Who can join 4-H?

Membership is open to all youth 5-18 years of age. The 4-H enrollment age is determined by the member's age as of October 1. Youth who have turned 5 and have not yet turned 19, by October 1st of each year are welcome to enroll. The 4-H year begins on October 1 with annual enrollment.

What will I learn?

Each 4-H member selects at least one project. Youth have the opportunity to choose an area that they have experience in, or are interested in learning about. Check with the club to see which projects they will be offering this year. Youth can also choose a self-directed project.

Share your knowledge

We are always looking for passionate adults who enjoy working with youth, to help lead 4-H clubs, activities, or projects. You can volunteer with your club or at the county level!

What else can I do as a 4-H member?

Youth can participate in county wide events such as summer camp, day camp, public presentations, county and state fair, parades... and so much more! There are also leadership opportunities such as becoming a club officer, joining the 4-H Council and becoming a camp counselor or counselor in training.
