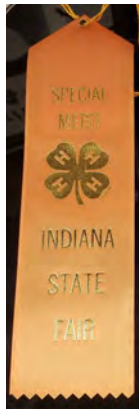
The Indiana 4-H mission is to provide real-life educational opportunities that develop young people who positively impact their community and world.

- Orange – exceptional blue ribbon exhibit (Merit)

Sweepstakes is awarded to the best overall exhibit in that 4-H project subject matter area.
