Achievement Winner – One individual will receive a \$1000 scholarship to be used for post high school study or training (i.e. college, trade school, or short course); the education is not restricted to Indiana **Runners-up** – Four individuals will receive \$250 scholarship to be used for post high school study or training (i.e. college, trade school, or short course); the education is not restricted to Indiana



An individual may only be selected as Achievement Winner one time. However, Runners-up can continue to be honored throughout their 4-H career. Financial awards are granted upon successful completion of one semester of post-high school educational training. The Extension Office will mail a form to your home address to complete right before the end of your Fall semester so that funds can be sent for your Spring semester.

Selection and Procedures

- 1. Applicants must be high school sophomores, juniors, or seniors participating in the Steuben County 4-H Program.
- 2. Applications are to be hand written and in ink.
- 3. Recommendations must come from individuals not related to the applicant.
- 4. Members will be notified of the interview time and date which will take place in June just prior to the 4-H Fair.
- 5. Interviews will include a "Display of Achievements" to be created by each applicant. The display must fit on a 4' x 4' card table (provided by the applicant) that will be on display during the fair.
- 6. Judging will be based on the following rubric:
 - 25% Application (all papers included in this packet)
 - 25% 4-H Record of Achievement (from your green 4-H Record Book; typed or handwritten photo copies are sufficient)
 - 25% Interview
 - 25% Display
- 7. <u>Applications are due to the Extension Office on or before May 31</u>, and submitting an application does not guarantee selection.

When you have completed this application, you will also have most of the information needed to complete an Indiana 4-H Foundation Scholarship Application.
