4-H Camp, June 7-9, 2023

4-H Camp at Epworth Forest in North Webster, Indiana will begin Wednesday, June 7 (tentatively 9 AM) and will end Friday, June 10 (tentatively 2 or 3 PM).

Any Steuben County 4-H member in grades 3-6 (22-23 school year) is welcome and the cost is \$190.00. (before the Steuben County 4-H Fair Board sponsorship, **keep reading!**)

The cost includes 7 meals, snacks, cabin lodging, temporary insurance, activities and instruction. The camp store may have snacks and other items available to purchase.

Special Note: The Steuben County 4-H Fair Board will pay 50% of your registration fee which is \$95.00, leaving the remaining 50% balance of \$95.00 due at time of registration.

Campers are asked to arrive at Epworth Forest 9-10 AM on Wednesday, June 7.

Closing ceremonies will likely be at 2 PM on Friday, June 9 with check-out at 3 PM.

To assure that you have the most fun at 4-H Camp this year, please register for camp in 4HOnline at v2.4honline.com as soon as possible. Payment will not be collected online, but the Extension Office can take cash or checks written to the Steuben County 4-H Fair Board. Camp registrations are taken on a first-come, first-serve basis, so don't wait or you might be too late!

Health Forms and Medical Information

A Registered Nurse will be on site during the entire stay at camp. The Nurse will be the sole person to administer your child's required medications, and said medications will be stored in a locked cabinet at all times.

Please complete the Health Form enclosed and turn in with your Camp Registration by May 1st.

Any medication the child may need should be



brought in the container in which they are issued (with medical orders and physician's name intact.)

Please place all medications in a zip-lock bag with camper's name.

Medications must be turned into the camp nurse during registration, so it is best not to pack them inside a suitcase.

You are responsible for your transportation to and from 4-H Camp. Once registration closes, we will supply a list of those Steuben County 4-H'ers who have registered for camp to hopefully assist with carpooling options, if desired.

Camp Rules

Non-aerosol Insect Repellent

Any youth breaking 4-H Camp behavior rules or determined to be a risk by the Extension Educator will be dismissed at the families expense.

There will be no reimbursements given for cancellations after June 1st or dismissals.

- 1. Any rules broken by camper(s) or counselor(s), if deemed severe enough, will result in 4-H'ers parents being called and the youth involved being sent home.
- 2. Camper must report illness/injury to nurse immediately.
- Close-toed shoes must be worn at all times except when traveling to and from the beachfront or showers. (Sandals or flip flops may be worn at those times.)
- 4. All items should be marked so that the camper will recognize his or her own belongings. This is especially important on swimsuits, cameras and other valuables.
- 5. Any medication taken regularly by a camper must be given to the camp nurse, who will dispense it to the camper at the designated time. Campers must contact the nurse at appropriate times when prescribed medication is to be taken.

- 6. No camper is allowed in the lake or in canoes except when a lifeguard is present.
- 7. No visitors are permitted during the camping period unless cleared with the Camp Director.
- 8. Campers are required to be present at all sessions. Full time participation is required! No youth will be allowed to leave and return for any reason.
- 9. Cell phones will not be permitted, please leave at home.
- 10. Epworth Forest or Purdue Extension Staff cannot be

responsible for articles or money left, lost or stolen at 4-H Camp.

Do not bring large amounts of money, expensive cameras and/or other valuable articles.

What you need when registering in 4HOnline:

- Parent/Guardian Email
- T-Shirt size (youth and adult sizes available)
- Cabin Mate Requests (optional)
- Accommodations needed or special dietary requests, if applicable
- Electronic photo of your child to upload
- Updates to your child's health form (if changes have occurred since enrollment)

How to register in 4HOnline:

- 1. Log in to 4HOnline at https://v2.4honline.com
- 2. Click "View" (in blue) next to the name of the 4-H member you want to register.
- 3. Click on "Events" on the left side of the screen (on a mobile device, click the 3 gray lines to open the menu).
- 4. Click on "Register for a new event" (in blue).
- 5. Select "2023 Northeast Indiana 4-H Camp" and click "Next."
- 6. Select on your camper type and click "Start Registration."

Note: The Payment window will say, "Payment for this invoice will be collected by Steuben County Area" because Steuben County set up the event in 4HOnline. Payment should be made at your local Extension Office to the entity in which your county designates via cash or check.
