RULES:

1. Community Judging of all 4-H Horseless projects will be at Project Check-In.
2. Posters must be displayed horizontally, sized 22" X 28" mounted on a firm backing (foam core board or other),and covered in clear plastic or other transparent material.
3. Choose a new topic of study for each additional year you are in this project.
4. All posters, notebooks, and display boards must include a reference list indicating where information was obtained, giving credit to the original author, to complete the 4-H member's exhibit. This reference list should/might include web site links, people and professionals interviewed, books, magazines, etc. It is recommended this reference list be attached to the back of a poster or display board, be the last page of a notebook, or included as part of the display visible to the public. A judge is not to discredit an exhibit for the manner in which references are listed.
5. **For exhibitors in Division 2 - 4, a demonstration, in addition to the poster exhibit, is required to complete this project. Please attach a signed demonstration sheet to the back of your poster. This demonstration can be at a community club meeting, a horse and pony clinic, a hippology/horse bowlmeeting, etc.**

EXHIBIT:

DIVISION 1 - GRADES 3-4

Your exhibit should relate to one of the following:

1. Poster with a picture showing the parts of a horse.
2. Poster with pictures showing different breeds of horses.
3. Poster with pictures showing different colors of horses.

DIVISION 2 - GRADES 5-6

Your exhibit should relate to one of the following:

1. A poster showing tack with information about each piece.
2. A poster explaining horse nutrition.
3. A poster showing and explaining items used in proper grooming.

DIVISION 3 - GRADES 7-8

Your exhibit should relate to one of the following:

1. A poster giving training information.
2. A poster showing hoof structure.
3. A poster showing and explaining items used in proper foot care.

4. A poster relating to horse safety.

DIVISION 4 - GRADES 9-12

Your exhibit should relate to one of the following:

1. A poster showing anatomy.
2. A poster showing examples of unsoundness
3. A poster showing and explaining the horse digestive system
4. A poster showing life cycles of internal parasites.
