Are you looking for something to do this summer? This letter contains information about several opportunities for 4-H members in 7th grade and above. Please read the letter carefully and **return the enclosed card to the Purdue Extension- Tipton County Office or reply online by Friday, April 25.**

<u>2025 4-H ROUND-UP AT PURDUE UNIVERSITY; JUNE 23-25</u>: open to 4-Hers currently enrolled in 7th, 8th, and 9th grades:

What is Roundup? Three days of events, activities and fun at Purdue University. There will be around 500 4-H'ers from the state in attendance. Go to <u>https://bit.ly/in4hroundup</u> for more information.

When is Roundup? June 23-25, 2025. Plan to leave around noon the 23rd (eat lunch before you come), and get back to Tipton about 2:00 p.m. on the 25th.

How much does it cost? The fee will be \$50 to the 4-Her, with 4-H Council picking up the rest of the registration fee. Please note, approximately three meals are on your own. There are several fast food places, as well as the student union, where you can buy a meal.

What do I do now? If you want to go, return the enclosed card with a \$50.00 deposit to the Purdue Extension Office by Friday, April 25. Soon after you return that card, you will be notified to complete a registration in 4-H Online ASAP; the sooner you register the more likely you'll get your first class options. Money will be returned if you cancel out before May 1. We will only take the first 10 4-Her's who return the card, so be sure to turn it in as soon as possible. 4-H BAND AND CHORUS- 4-H Band (June 21-23) and 4-H Chorus (June 21-24) are available to youth who have completed grades 9-12. The State 4-H Band and State 4-H Chorus workshops are immersive, dynamic opportunities to learn about musical performance alongside new friends from across Indiana guided by some of the best music performance teachers and staff in Indiana. Both workshops culminate in performances to over 500 people during 4-H Round-Up. State 4-H Band is a three day experience, while State 4-H Chorus is four days in length. Participants get a taste of college life by living in a Purdue Residence Hall, eating in a University dining hall, and exploring campus. Both workshops are open to all high school age youth; 4-H membership is not required. Each experience requires a recommendation from a band or choir director, and selection is made by the State 4-H Band and State 4-H Chorus Directors and Coordinator. Applications are due online by **MAY 1**, please return the interest card prior to Friday, April 25 so an online application can be started for you. MINI 4-H DAY CAMP COUNSELORS - open to anyone currently enrolled in 7th grade and above

What is a Mini 4-H Day Camp Counselor? Do you remember looking up to older 4-H members? Mini Day Camp Counselors have the opportunity to guide Mini 4-H members through the camp activities, build friendships with younger campers and other counselors, and become a role model to a future 4-H members.

When is Mini 4-H Day Camp? June 4-6, from approximately 8:40 am-1:30 pm (a schedule will be sent out later). A mandatory counselor training will be held on <u>Friday</u>, <u>May 30 from 1-3 pm</u> in the Purdue Extension Office.

How much does it cost? Mini 4-H Camp Counselors pay a \$10 fee to help cover the expense of their t-shirt and pool entrance.

What do I do now? Return the enclosed card and check the line for Mini 4-H Camp Counselor, along with \$10 to the Purdue Extension Office by Friday, April 25. Plan to attend the May 30 Counselor Training from 1-3 pm.

<u>4-H ACADEMY @ PURDUE; JUNE 11-13:</u>- open to anyone currently enrolled in high school. If you've been to Round Up and loved visiting the Purdue campus, this is an excellent follow up!

What is 4-H Academy @ Purdue? 4-H Academy @ Purdue workshops are designed to give students a hands-on opportunity to explore various subjects and career fields in a university setting, taking advantage of the many resources available at Purdue University. When is 4-H Academy @ Purdue? 4-H Academy @ Purdue will be held June 11-13 at Purdue University. Participants will leave on the morning of the 11th and get back mid-afternoon on the 13th. Brian will be attending 4-H Camp on these dates, so participants will be responsible for transportation to and from Purdue campus. The Purdue Extension- Tipton County office will help participants connect so they can arrange carpooling if desired.

How much does it cost? 4-H Academy @ Purdue will cost \$50 to participants.

What do I do now? Return the enclosed sheet by April 25. Enclose your \$50 deposit. As soon as the sheet is received, the Purdue Extension office will open an online registration through 4-H Online that you will need to complete ASAP; it is due by May 1. We will take the first 10 4-Hers who return their cards. Some workshops have participant limits, so turn it in early if you are interested! PLEASE NOTE: Despite what the flyer says, the price is \$50 and the deadline is April 25 to the Purdue Extension- Tipton County Office.
