Why are we doing this?

We want you to keep good 4-H records so that the year you become 15 years of age, you will have the information that you need to do an Achievement Record Book for State competition. This allows you to be in State Honor Group, win a trip to National 4-H Congress and possibly win a 4-H Scholarship for college.

Instructions

The following pages are the forms you fill out for your project. Each section begins with directions for completion of each form. If additional sheets are needed for any of the forms, please stop by the 4-H office.

1. Participation in the local 4-H Club or group. (Begin with your first year in 4-H)
 - a. Write down the year on which you are reporting.
 - b. Write down how many meetings your club held.
 - c. Write down how many meetings you attended.
 - d. Write down any offices you held.
 - e. Write down any committees you worked on and put a CH after it if you were the chairperson.
 - f. Total the two columns in lead pencil so that you can add to it next year.

2. 4-h Projects – Enrollment and Exhibits

Begin with your first year in 4-H and list your projects by year. Use one horizontal row for each year in 4-H and one vertical column for each project (each year you will complete a new row for the new year, but use the same column for a single project). List the project name at the top of the appropriate column. Indicate the project unit, total size of your project, what you exhibited, and all other work done including articles, animals, recipes, etc. Total the project column in pencil. List county exhibit ratings in column C, and State Fair exhibit ratings in column S. Each form has enough space for three projects, so stop by the 4-H Office for additional copies of this form if needed.
