Dear Mini 4-Her,

Are you interested in participating in fun 4-H activities this summer? Do you like to spend time with friends and older 4-Hers while singing songs, playing games, doing crafts, and learning more about your world?

**Mini 4-H Day Camp** is a place where you can do all of these things and MORE! Mini 4-H is available to anyone currently enrolled in kindergarten- 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. This year's theme is "Mini 4-H Land," where we will explore the colorful world of Candy Land and other favorite board games!

Mini 4-H Day Camp will be held June 1-3, 2022. Wednesday and Thursday, June 1 and 2 will occur at the 4-H Fairgrounds from approximately 9 am-1 pm (final schedule will be sent closer to the date) and Friday, June 3 will take place at the Tipton City Park from 9 am- 12:30 pm and includes a trip to the pool (weather permitting).

Mini 4-Hers will be put into groups of approximately 5-8 other campers and will be led by 3 or 4 teenaged counselors (depending on camp enrollment numbers). These groups form communities who have their own flag and chant and spend time learning and growing together throughout the camp. I have seen really special friendships form among campers and with their counselors.

If you are interested in attending Mini 4-H Day Camp, please log into the Mini 4-Her's 4-H Online profile, search for the event "Tipton County Mini 4-H Day Camp" under "Events" and complete the registration. Instructions on how to do these steps is enclosed in this letter. A \$20 fee will cover the cost of a t-shirt, admission to the city pool, and other supplies used during Day Camp- please send this to the Purdue Extension- Tipton County office by April 29. Checks can be made payable to "Tipton County 4-H Council" with the youth's name and "Mini 4-H Day Camp" in the memo. If you choose to drop off the money after business hours, the black mailbox on the sidewalk in front of the office is a locked, secure drop box that is checked every business day. Campers will bring a sack lunch on Wednesday and Thursday and will be provided a cookout picnic lunch on Friday. **The deadline to register for Mini 4-H Day Camp is Friday, April 29, 2022.**

Once you enroll for Mini 4-H Day Camp more information, including a final schedule, will be sent to you closer to the time of the camp.

We hope to see you at Mini 4-H Day Camp!!!




1. Complete the 4-H Online login process to access your family profile and member list. Click “View” by the member you intend to register for an Event that registration has been started by your county office

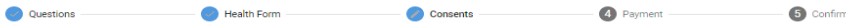




#### Behavioral Criteria for 4-H Events and Activities

To 4-H members, volunteers, parents and the public: When attending, participating or acting on behalf of the 4-H program, all persons are expected to conduct themselves in accordance with accepted standards of social behavior, to respect rights of others, and to refrain from any conduct which may be injurious to the 4-H program. The following actions constitute misconduct for which persons may be subject to disciplinary consequences and/or dismissal from the program:

- (a) Dishonesty in connection with any 4-H activity by cheating or knowingly furnishing false information.
- (b) Alteration or unauthorized use of 4-H records.
- (c) Obstruction or disruption of any 4-H activity or aiding and encouraging other persons to engage in such conduct.
- (d) Failure to comply or aiding or encouraging other persons not to comply with specific terms and conditions of a given project, contest, or activity.
- (e) Failure to comply with directions of 4-H officials acting in the proper performance of their duties.
- (f) Inhumane treatment of 4-H animal projects.

There are many opportunities for 4-H members, volunteers, parents and the public to participate in 4-H events and activities. When involved in such experiences, members, volunteers, parents and the public are expected to follow all rules and regulations as outlined by those responsible for the specific program or activity. In all such 4-H activities, the following constitute a violation of behavioral
